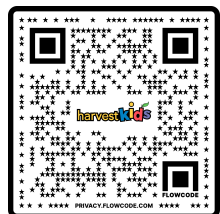

JESUS WAS TEMPTED

Matthew 4; Mark 1; Luke 4

IS JESUS GOD OR A HUMAN? JESUS IS FULLY GOD AND FULLY HUMAN.

After Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River, the Holy Spirit led Him into the wilderness for 40 days to be tempted by the devil. Jesus didn't have anything to eat.

The devil said to Jesus, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."

But Jesus answered him by quoting the Old Testament, "Man must not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God."

The devil also took Jesus up on a very high mountain. The devil said, "I will give you authority over all these kingdoms if you will bow down and worship me."

Jesus again answered with words from the Old Testament: "Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only."

The devil took Jesus to Jerusalem and had Him stand on the very top of the temple. The devil said, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here."

Jesus again responded with Scripture, saying, "It is said: Do not test the Lord your God."

The devil left Jesus for a time. Angels came and began to serve Jesus. News about Him spread everywhere.

Christ Connection: Like us, Jesus experienced temptation. But unlike us, Jesus never sinned. When we repent and believe Jesus died on the cross to pay for our sins and rose again, God credits us with Jesus' perfect life.
