## JESUS AT PASSOVER

John 2

### DID JESUS EVER SIN? NO, JESUS NEVER SINNED.

Jesus went to Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. When He arrived at the temple, Jesus saw people selling oxen, sheep, and doves. This made Jesus angry because the temple was a place of worship and prayer—not a house of business.

Jesus drove everyone out of the temple. He poured out all the coins from the money changers and turned over all their tables. “Get these things out of here!” He said.

Then the Jews said, “What sign will you show us for doing these things?”

Jesus replied, “Destroy this temple, and I will raise it up in three days.”

But Jesus wasn't speaking about the temple of God. Jesus was speaking about the temple of His body. Later, after Jesus died on the cross and was raised from the dead, His disciples remembered Jesus said these things.

As Jesus remained in Jerusalem during the Passover, many believed in His name when they saw the signs He was doing.

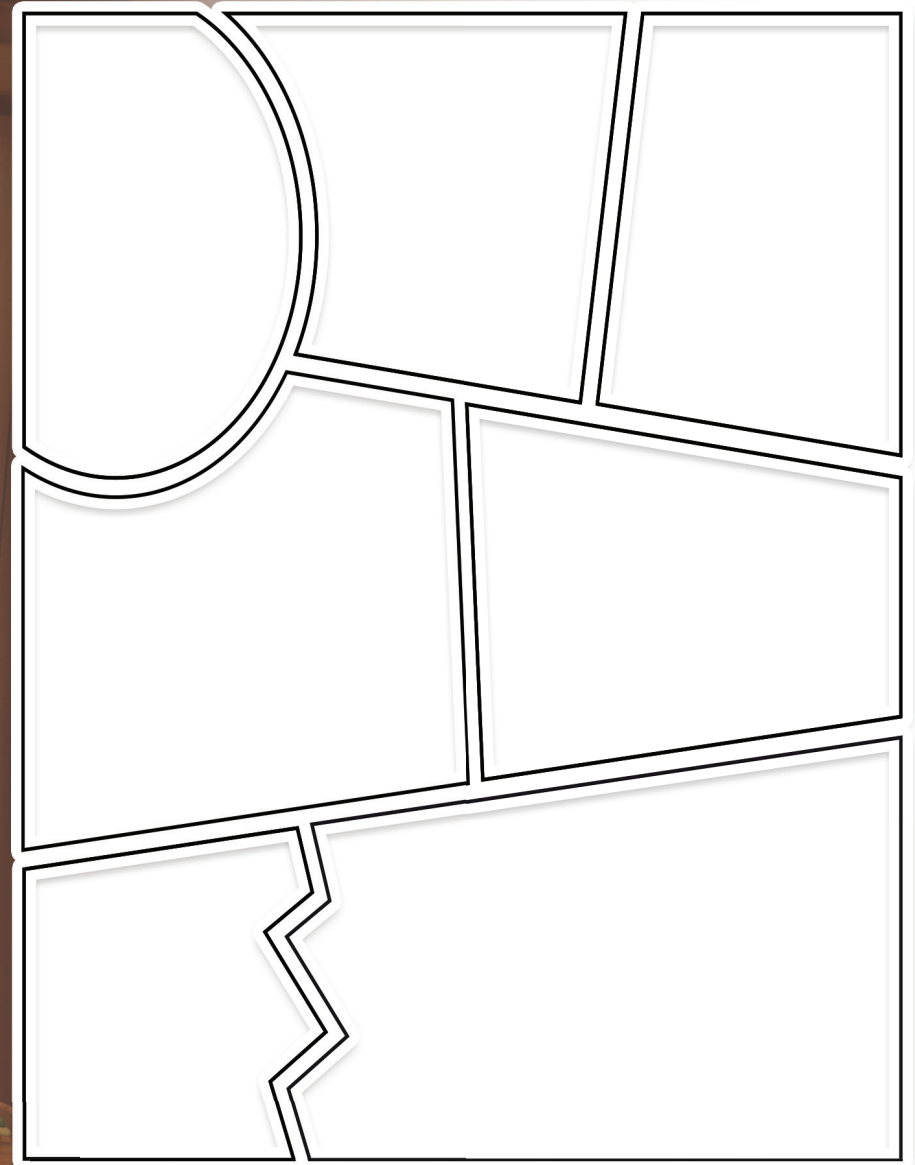
