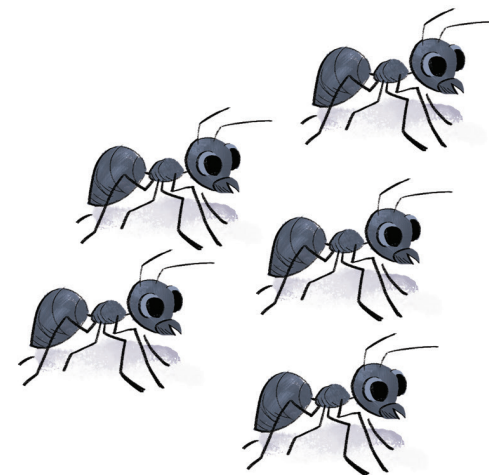
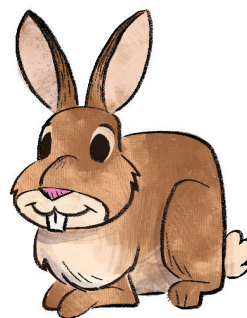
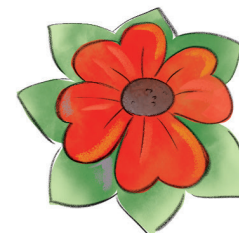
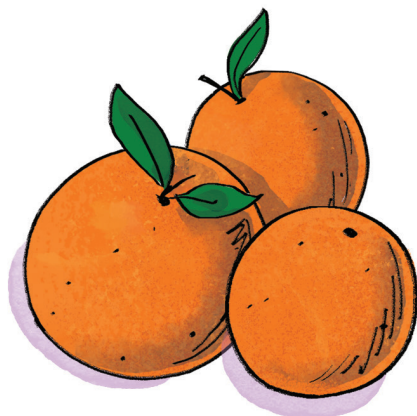
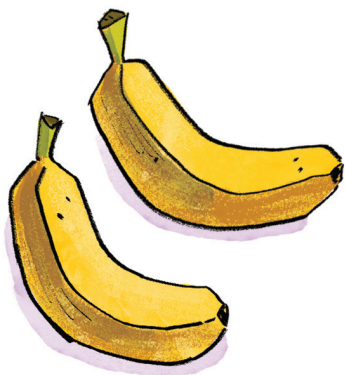


Which Is Greater?
