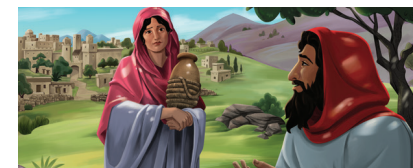

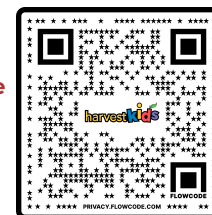

## JESUS AND THE SAMARITAN WOMAN

John 4

### **DID JESUS EVER SIN? NO, JESUS NEVER SINNED.**

Jesus became very tired and sat down at a well. At noon, a Samaritan woman came to draw water, and Jesus asked her for a drink. She replied, "How is it that you, a Jew, are asking me, a Samaritan, for a drink?"

Jesus answered, "If you knew who I was, you would be asking me for living water." The woman asked Jesus where this living water came from.

"Everyone who drinks from this water will get thirsty again," Jesus said. "But whoever drinks from the water that I will give him will never get thirsty again." The woman asked for this water.

"Go call your husband," Jesus told her, "and come back here." The woman said she didn't have a husband. Jesus replied, "You are correct—you don't have a husband. You've had five husbands."
