JESUS REJECTED IN NAZARETH

Luke 4

**WHY DID JESUS PERFORM MIRACLES?
JESUS PERFORMED MIRACLES TO GLORIFY GOD, TO SHOW HE IS THE
SON OF GOD, AND TO CARE FOR PEOPLE.**

While Jesus was traveling through Galilee, He came to the city of Nazareth, where He had grown up. He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath. He stood up to read and was given a scroll that contained the writings of the prophet Isaiah. Here is what He read:

“The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because He has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to those in prison and to give sight to the blind to set free those in oppression, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.”

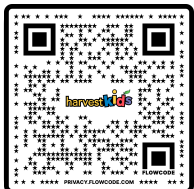
Everyone in the synagogue was looking at Jesus as He said, “Today, this Scripture has been fulfilled.” Jesus was claiming that Isaiah was talking about Him!

Everyone was amazed by the way Jesus was talking. The people had known Jesus since He was a boy, and they wondered how Isaiah’s words could be about Him.

Jesus said, “Truly I tell you, no prophet is accepted in his own hometown.”

This made the people in the synagogue very angry. They chased Jesus out of town and planned on throwing Him over a cliff! But Jesus passed through the crowd and went on His way.
