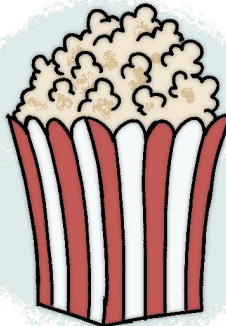
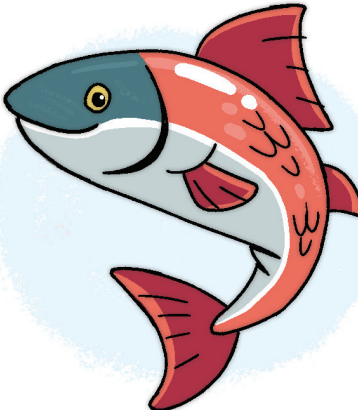
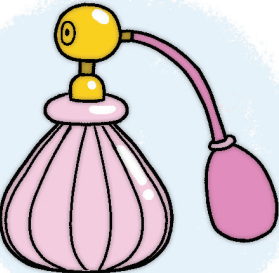
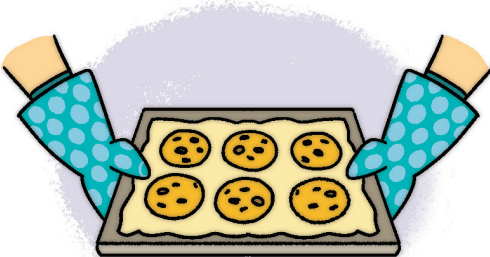


What Smells Good?

WHAT IS PRAYER?

PRAYER IS TALKING WITH GOD TO PRAISE HIM, ASK HIM FOR HELP, AND CONFESS OUR SINS.

One of the Pharisees named Simon invited Jesus to dinner at his house. A sinful woman carrying a jar of perfume came to Him. Then she began to wash His feet with her tears, kissed them, and rubbed perfume on them.

The Pharisee thought to himself, "If this man were a prophet, He would know who is touching Him and what kind of woman she is—she's a sinner!"

Jesus said, "A man let two different people borrow some money. He loaned one man 50 expensive coins, and he loaned the other man 500 expensive coins.
