WHAT IS PRAYER?

PRAYER IS TALKING WITH GOD TO PRAISE HIM, ASK HIM FOR HELP, AND CONFESS OUR SINS.

As Jesus was teaching, someone said to him, “Teacher, tell my brother to divide his inheritance money with me.”

Jesus said to the crowd, “Be on guard against greed! Owning many possessions will not make you happy or content.”

Jesus told them a parable: “There was a rich man who had a great farm that produced a lot of crops. The rich man thought to himself, I’ll tear down my barns and build even bigger ones. Then I’ll store so much away that I can rest for many years and just enjoy life.”

“God came to the rich man and said, ‘This is the night that your life will end. Who will enjoy your possessions now?’

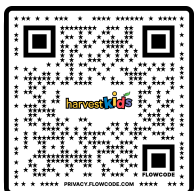
Jesus said, “This is how it will be if you store up treasure for yourself and are not rich toward God.”

Jesus said to His disciples, “Don’t worry about your life. Can you add one moment to your life by worrying?”

Jesus also told the people to think about the wildflowers. He reminded them how God cares for His creation, especially people who are much more important than flowers.
