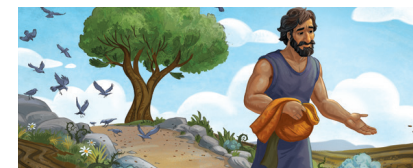


Seed Search

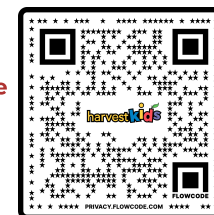

JESUS TAUGHT IN PARABLES

Matthew 13; Mark 4; Luke 8

IS THE BIBLE TRUE? YES, THE BIBLE IS TRUE AND HAS NO ERROR.

Jesus told a story about a man planting seeds. Jesus began, "A sower went out to plant seeds in his field. Some seeds fell on a hard path. Birds swooped down and ate the seeds.

"Other seeds fell on rocky ground. They sprouted quickly, but the soil was too shallow for roots to grow. When the sun got hot, the plants died. Some seeds fell among thorns. The thorns grew and choked the plants. But some seeds fell on good soil. These seeds grew into healthy plants and made more grain than the farmer had planted!"

Jesus' disciples asked Him, "Why do You tell stories like this?"

Jesus replied, "Not everyone is ready to understand the truth about God's kingdom. I speak in parables so that those who are ready will understand."

Jesus explained the story. He said, "The seeds on the path are like people who hear the truth but don't understand it. The evil one snatches away what was planted in their hearts. The seeds on rocky ground are like people who hear the truth and believe at first, but when it becomes hard to follow God's Word, they give up. The seeds among the thorns are like people who hear the truth, but do not give God's Word room to grow in their hearts. But the seeds in the good soil are like people who understand the gospel and let it change their lives. They grow in faith and share the good news!"
