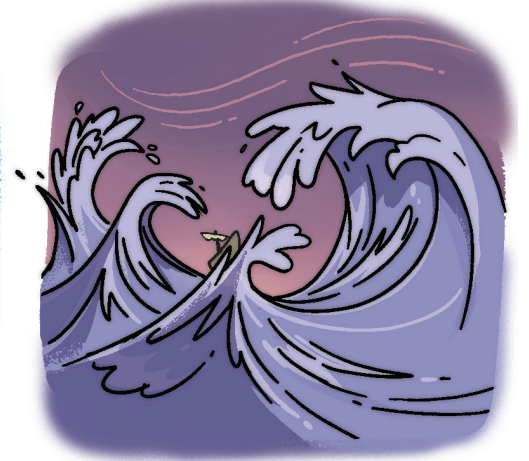
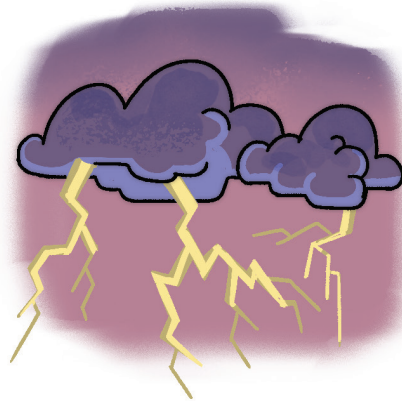


Circle What Is Calm

Jesus showed He has power over nature. Jesus is God's Son. He came to save people from sin. When we trust in Jesus, He forgives our sin and gives us life with God forever.

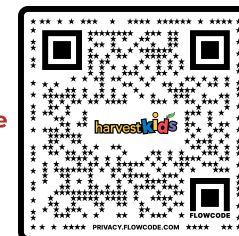

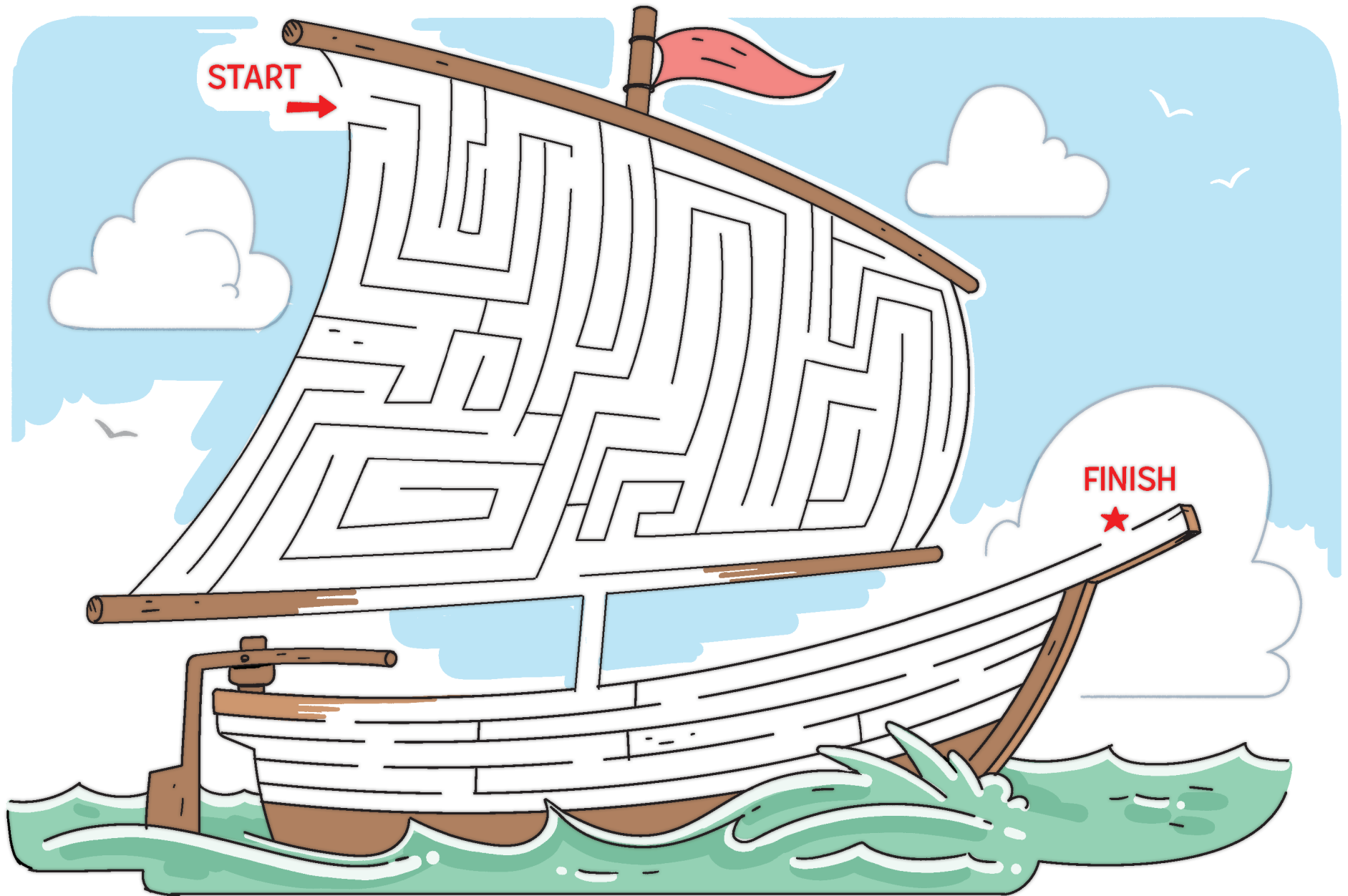

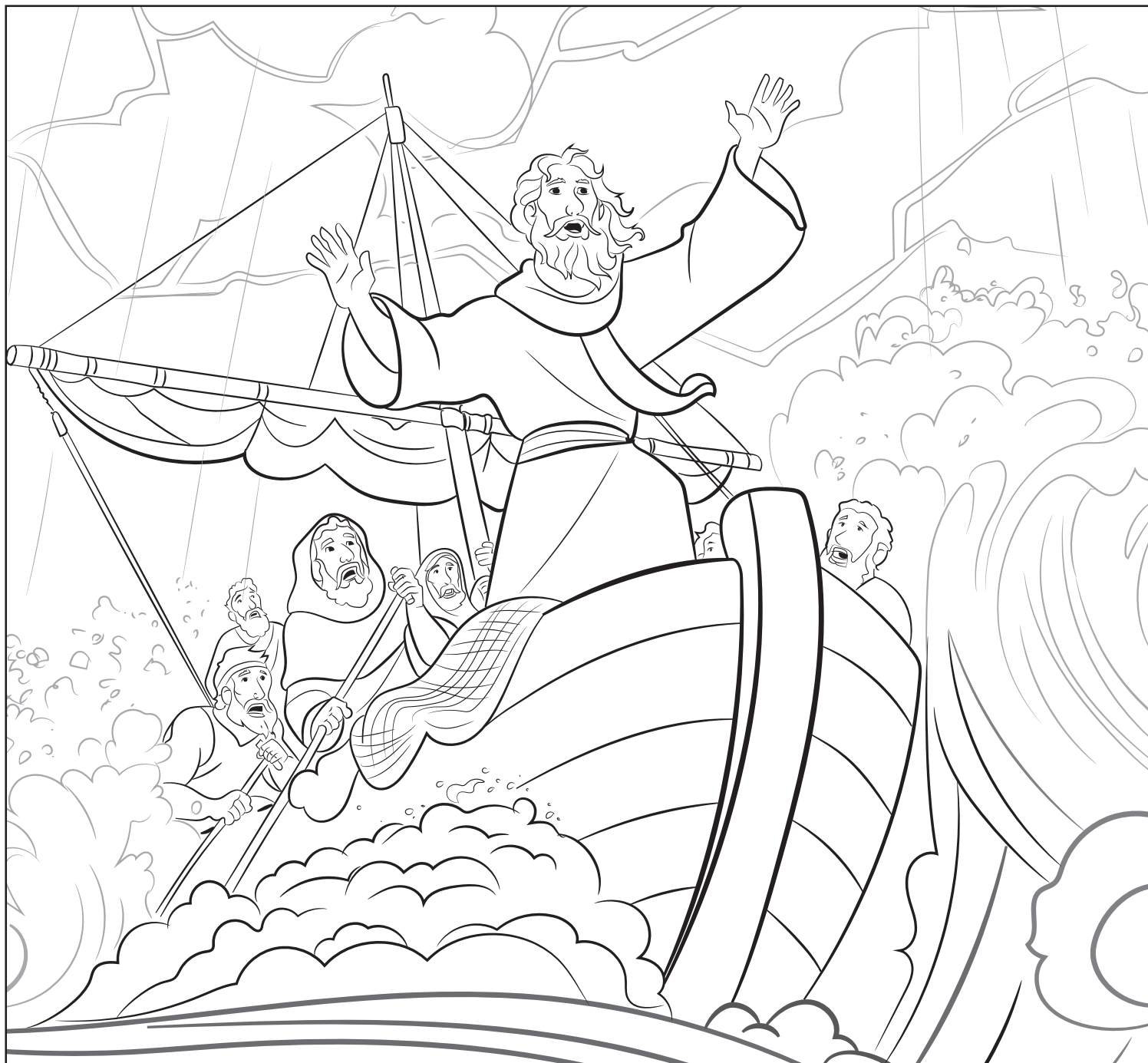


Maze at Sea

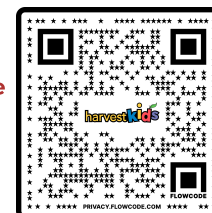

**IS THE BIBLE TRUE?
