PHILIPPIANS 3:1-21

What was Paul's religious "resumé" in verses 4–6, and why does he consider all of it "loss" compared to knowing Christ (vv. 7–8)?

How does Paul contrast those who "mind earthly things" (vv. 18–19) with those whose "citizenship is in heaven" (vv. 20–21)?

Where are you tempted to base your spiritual identity or worth? Is it past achievements, religious performance, status, or reputation, rather than Christ's righteousness alone?

Do you share Paul's deep yearning to "know Him and the power of His resurrection" (v. 10), or have you become complacent in your walk with God?

List 2–3 things outside of Jesus you tend to rely on for self-worth or security (e.g., success, approval, financial stability, performance).
