## GUIDELINE SPOTLIGHT

**SHARING** Be sensitive to the amount of time you share. If someone is sharing and makes a point that really connects with you, resist telling a story that makes the same point.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. (vv. 3-6) John uses the word “know” multiple times, but he links it to specific actions. According to these verses, what is the primary evidence that we actually know God? What does John say about the person who claims to know Him but ignores His commands?
  
2. (vv. 7-11) John speaks about a commandment that is both “old” and “new.” What is this commandment (see v. 10)? How can a commandment be “old” (from the beginning) yet “new” in the way Jesus lived it out? Why is it impossible to ‘walk in the light’ while hating a brother or sister?
