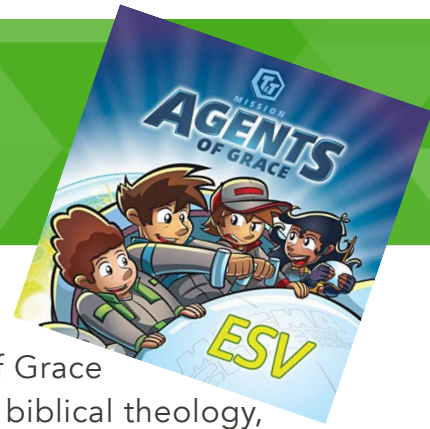




Mission: Agents of Grace Handbook

This year we are going through the blue Mission: Agents of Grace Handbook which focuses on attributes of God, the importance of biblical theology, the seven "I AM" statements of Jesus Christ from the Gospel of John, and discipleship basics. Please read the Parent Overview on the inside cover of the handbook and also refer to the all-together handbook schedule on the back cover to know what section your child is on each week. All clubbers work on the **SAME** section each week so that each T&T handbook lesson is integrated throughout the night.

Passing a Section

T&T typically completes one section a night following the T&T Handbook Schedule. In order to pace all clubbers to finish their handbooks by the end of the year, the end of the unit review sections are doubled up with the last section of the unit.

To pass a section in the Mission: Agents of Grace, each clubber must complete 4 parts each week:



Start Here – Intro activity



Explore – Bible study at home



Memorize – Bible Memory verse



Review – Review the previous section's memory verse



Each section also includes optional elements such as a prayer section guiding students on how to specifically pray for different countries in the world. Even further Silver Extra Credit opportunities for kids who want a greater challenge and allows them to dive deeper into the weekly Bible topic with additional Bible studies and Gold Extra Credit verses.

We value the lifelong impact that memorizing scripture will have on your child's life, but recognize it takes practice and commitment to strengthening that muscle. For our younger clubbers or if your child struggles with memorization, we have shortened verses they can use until they build up to doing the full verse later in the year. 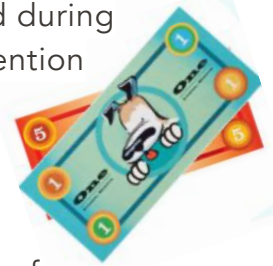
Truth & Training Overview



Complete Bible Study & Memorization AT HOME

The T&T program is designed to encourage kids to prioritize the spiritual habits of scripture memorization, prayer, and personal Bible Study into their weekly rhythms. Handbook sections should be **COMPLETED AT HOME** before coming to T&T each week. This encourages parents/guardians to be involved and allows the child to reflect and prepare for the lessons and verses for that week. Preparing at home gives clubbers a better opportunity to be more engaged during the Large Group teaching and Small Group discussion as well as aids in retention of the Biblical concepts.

Incentives



T&T leaders are so excited to partner with parents in the discipleship of their children and to offer fun incentives to motivate students. Awana Bucks can be earned by completing the Handbook Bible study at home, memorizing the verse, and being prepared by wearing their uniform, bringing a Bible & their handbook. Extra bucks are earned for Silver & Gold Extra Credit. Every 4-6 weeks there will a T&T Store to spend their Awana Bucks. After 4 sections are completed, students earn a Chevron Award they can decorate their uniform with.



Additionally, students who have their verses memorized and come early before Awana begins at 5:45, can recite their verse to a Fast Track leader to get a prize.

For clubbers who complete every section, they can earn a Book Completion Award at the end of the year.

Not able to complete a Section or Absent?

If a clubber misses a week, they will skip the lesson they missed so they can to continue the same lesson with the group. At the end of small group, clubbers are welcome to make up any missed sections with their leader.
