### **Exodus Study #27**

#### **Exodus 25:1-40**

##### **1. Verses 1-9**

- a. What does God require about how the people give in verse 2?
- b. What does verse 8 reveal about God's desire for His people?
- c. Why does God specify "according to all that I show you," and how does verse 9 challenge the idea of worshiping God however we want?

##### **2. Verses 10-22**

- a. What stands out about the design and materials of the Ark?
- b. Why is it significant that the Law is inside the Ark but the Mercy Seat is on top?
- c. What is significant about where God says He will meet with them?

##### **3. Verses 23-30**

- a. What might the bread represent being before the Lord "always" in verse 30?
- b. How does this section reflect God's relationship with His people?
- c. In what ways do we depend on God daily, like the bread represents?

##### **4. Verses 31-40**

- a. What stands out about the lampstand's design and craftsmanship?
- b. Why is light important in the Tabernacle, and how does the continual light symbolize God's presence?
- c. How does verse 40 reinforce the importance of obedience in worship?

## How to Study God’s Word Effectively:

Remember the simple yet powerful approach we’ve learned:

1. Soak in the Passage
  - Read the passage multiple times. Each time, pray and ask God to speak to you—inviting His Spirit to give you insight, clarity, and understanding.
2. Follow the O.I.A. Method:
  - **Observation** – Write down everything you notice in the text, even the simplest details. Don’t overlook the obvious—just note what you see.
  - **Interpretation** – What do those observations mean? Seek to understand the message and context of what you’ve written down.
  - **Application** – Based on what you’ve read and understood, how does this truth apply to your life? What is God calling you to believe, change, or do?
