Exodus 28:1-29:46

1. Verses 28:1-30

- a. What stands out about the remaining garments and their purpose?
- b. Why is it so important that Aaron follows these instructions exactly?
- c. What does this section reveal about God's holiness and the seriousness of approaching Him?

3. Verses 29:1-21

- a. What steps are involved in consecrating the priests?
- b. Why are washing, sacrifice, and blood all necessary?
- c. What might the blood on the ear, hand, and foot symbolize?

4. Verses 29:22-46

- a. What stands out about the ongoing sacrifices and consecration process?
- b. Why does God emphasize meeting with His people in this context?
- c. How does this section connect sacrifice with God's presence among His people?

How to Study God’s Word Effectively:

Remember the simple yet powerful approach we’ve learned:

1. Soak in the Passage
 - Read the passage multiple times. Each time, pray and ask God to speak to you—inviting His Spirit to give you insight, clarity, and understanding.
2. Follow the O.I.A. Method:
 - **Observation** – Write down everything you notice in the text, even the simplest details. Don’t overlook the obvious—just note what you see.
 - **Interpretation** – What do those observations mean? Seek to understand the message and context of what you’ve written down.
 - **Application** – Based on what you’ve read and understood, how does this truth apply to your life? What is God calling you to believe, change, or do?
