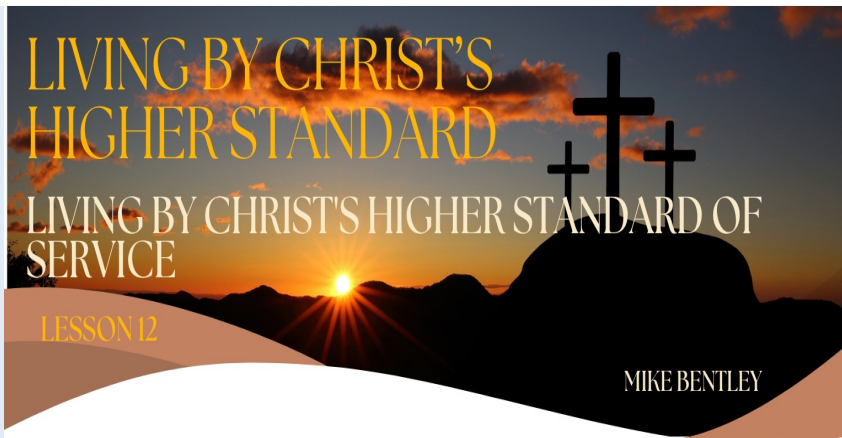

In Matthew 5:47, Jesus asked a question that indicates the higher expectations He has for His followers: "And if you greet your brethren only, what do you do more than others? Do not even the tax collectors do so?" This question was concerning the practice of love, but its principle extends to all kinds of works done by disciples of Christ. We should be doing more than those who are not His followers. Let's consider the busier and better service of Christians.

**As Christians We Need To \_\_\_\_\_!** Christians should be the hardest working people on earth. (**Ecclesiastes 9:10; Ephesians 4:28; 2 Thessalonians 3:10-12.**) Christians ought to be the hardest working people any employer could ever hire, for we are to work as if we are employed by Christ Himself. Compare these Scriptures: **Ephesians 6:5-8; Colossians 3:22-24.** Such diligence is part of our responsibility to be exemplary in our behavior within the world. For example Notice: **1 Thess. 4:11-12.**

**As we work hard for \_\_\_\_\_ returns, we should work even harder for an \_\_\_\_\_ return.** The point here is not to diminish the tremendous material blessings that God gives us, but relatively speaking they are as nothing compared to the eternal spiritual blessings we can have through Christ Jesus. Consider Solomon's comments about hard work and its temporal rewards in **Ecclesiastes 2:22-23.** However, there is work that has eternal rewards according to Jesus in **John 6:27.**

**What good works should Christians be doing?**

- Being obedient to Jesus in all things (**Col. 3:17; Heb. 5:9.**)
- Teaching the gospel of Christ (**Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 8:4; 2 Tim. 4:2.**)
- Praying (**Luke 18:1; Rom. 12:12; Phil. 4:6; 1 Thess. 5:17.**)
- Edifying fellow Christians within the church's assemblies (**Eph. 4:11-16; Heb. 10:24-25.**)
- Edifying fellow Christians outside the assemblies (**Eph. 4:29.**)
- Caring for one's own family (**1 Tim. 5:8.**)
- Caring for the needy, especially among fellow Christians (**Jas. 1:27; 1 John 3:17.**)
- Giving for the work of the church (**2 Cor. 9:7-8.**)
- Resisting the devil and his servants (**Eph. 6:10-13**)

God has fully equipped us to do every good work. (**Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 1:3.**)

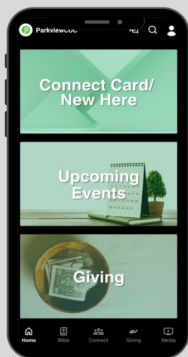
