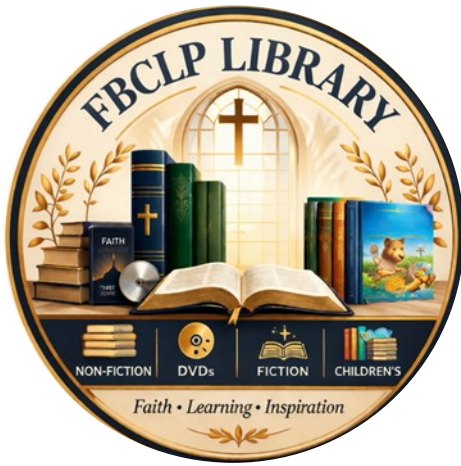

The truth is, God has not changed. His faithfulness remains constant. But when we forget what He has already done, it becomes difficult to trust Him with what lies ahead.

We see this clearly in the story of the Israelites. Despite witnessing incredible miracles—deliverance from Egypt, the parting of the Red Sea, and daily provision in the wilderness—they quickly forgot. In moments of hardship, they doubted, complained, and feared.

It's easy to read their story and wonder how they could forget so quickly—but if we're honest, we often do the same.

The Power of Remembering

Remembering is more than simply recalling the past—it is a way of strengthening our faith in the present.

When we intentionally reflect on God's goodness:

- Our fear is replaced with confidence
- Our anxiety gives way to peace
- Our doubt is overcome by trust

Throughout the Bible, God instructed His people to build reminders of His faithfulness. They set up stones, observed feasts, and told stories from generation to generation. These were not just traditions—they were intentional acts of remembrance.

Today, we may not build physical altars, but we are still called to remember in meaningful ways.

Sometimes, the most powerful words we can speak in a difficult season are: "I don't understand this moment—but I remember what God has already done."

Looking Back to Move Forward

Imagine walking down a dark path with only a small light in front of you. You can't see very far ahead, and it's easy to feel uncertain. But if you stop and look behind you, you'll see the ground you've already covered. You'll see how far you've come.

That's what remembering does. It reminds us that even when the future feels unclear, God has been guiding us every step of the way. Cont. p. 8

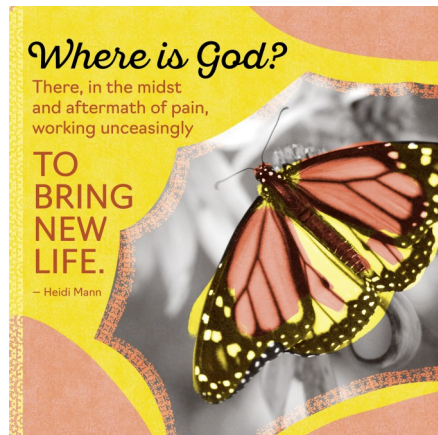

Living a Life of Remembrance: If we want to grow in our faith, we must be intentional about remembering. Here are a few simple ways to do that:

- **Write it down:** Keep a journal of answered prayers and moments where God has been faithful.
- **Share your story:** Testimonies not only strengthen your faith, but they encourage others.
- **Create reminders:** Whether it's a meaningful verse, a date, or a personal milestone, mark the moments that matter.
- **Practice gratitude daily:** Take time each day to thank God for specific blessings.
- **Stay rooted in Scripture:** God's Word continually reminds us of His character and promises.



A Final Encouragement You may be walking through a season of uncertainty right now. You may have questions, struggles, or challenges that feel overwhelming. But take heart in this truth: the same God who was faithful in your past is faithful in your present—and He will be faithful in your future. So when life feels heavy, don't just look ahead—look back.

Remember His goodness.

Remember His provision.

Remember His promises.

And let what God has already done give you confidence in what He is still doing.

Light refreshments will be available in church fellowship hall immediately following the prayer service (sponsored by WOM's).



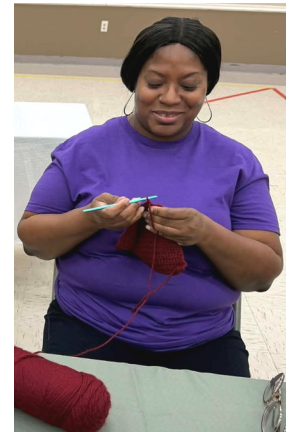
Pastor Gary is currently scheduling devotions for UPWARD halftimes.
