 - A. Compassion (Luke 10:30-37; Matt 9:35-36; Luke 7:12-15)**
 - B. Kindness (2 Samuel 9:1-8; Titus 3:4-5; Ephesians 2:7)**
 - C. Humility (John 3:30; Philippians 2:3-4; 5-8)**
 - D. Gentleness (Numbers 12:3; Matt 11:28; Luke 9)**
 - E. Patience (Romans 2:4; James 5:7-8; 2 Peter 3:9)**
