- 6) a. In 4:1, what are the Lord’s expectations for those who are in authority over workers?
- b. What circumstances might cause you (as one in authority) to violate these expectations?
- c. How do you respond when your employer, team director, supervisor, etc. violate these expectations?

Application:

The study questions deal with issues of attitude and behavior in work situations.

Look back through all the questions and answers. Can you identify an attitude or action relating to your work that isn’t right? Confess it to the Lord, ask His forgiveness, and take corrective action. (If others have been negatively affected, apologize to them and ask for their forgiveness.)
