



Information for Kid's Pastor or Camp Coordinator

Thank you for coordinating Kid's Camp for the children of your church. A breakdown of costs for 2026 is as follows:

Little Beaver Camp Week 1 & 2:

Early Registration - \$350 (Early bird by June 22 for Week 1 & June 29th for Week 2)

Late registration - \$370

PK/MK & Leaders - \$260

All registrations and payment will be done online at aknextgen.org. Click on Kid's Camp registration. We must have information about the number of kids, leaders, allergies, and medical information ahead of time to adequately prepare.

The following items are essential for the children/leaders that come to camp.
Please make sure all are completed before you come to camp.

1. Online registration. Parents can register campers individually or you can register and pay for your whole group at once. You can find options on the registration form. Instructions for creating a group and for partial payments by parents and scholarships by the church will be included.
2. Volunteer Screening forms. We have a strict screening policy for all adult volunteers. Each leader must be screened and approved (you can download our screening form on aknextgen.org or akministrynetwork.org). After completing the screening form, you can mail or fax it to the Network Office. (1048 W. Int'l Airport Rd., Suite 101, Anchorage, AK 99518 or Fax # 907-562-2352). These forms must be completed in time for the screening process (2 weeks prior). You must have your Pastor's signature. All volunteers must be approved before camp. Screening forms must be resubmitted every 5 years. The cost of screening is \$15. You can pay this online at the network website. Also, a training video will be sent to each volunteer to watch before coming to camp. This saves time at camp and each leader will have to sign a statement affirming that they watched the training video.
3. Volunteer Camp Fee. A fee of \$260 is required for each adult volunteer. This is the cost for food, lodging, etc. We are asking each church to consider paying this fee for each volunteer they send to camp. You can find a short registration form for volunteers and payment of fees on the registration platform. We appreciate each volunteer for their willingness to come and be a leader for camp.

4. Lice Check. Due to some issues in the past, we are asking that each group check their kids for lice before camp. PLEASE HELP US WITH THIS. We will have an onsite check at camp registration. If lice are present, kids must be treated before staying at camp.

5. Leader/Child Ratio. We need a minimum of 1 volunteer for every 7 campers of each gender you send to camp. Please send your trusted volunteers to help us. A pastor's recommendation is required as a part of the screening form.

6. Age of Campers. The age group for campers is 7 to 12 years. Each year some campers get homesick. Please use your discretion as to whom is ready for camp and who may not be ready to spend 4 nights away from home. Homesickness is difficult for the child and for the leader. Since you know the children you are coming with, I would ask that you make the call as whether a child is ready to attend camp or possibly wait until another year.
