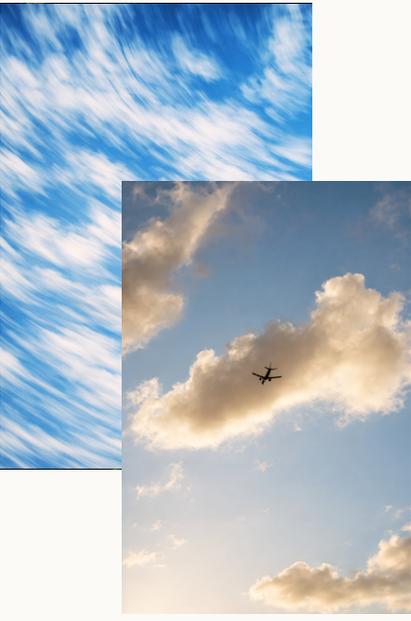




**Twenty One ————— Days

# day twelve:

## *rooted in fellowship*

*“Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up.” Ecclesiastes 4:9-10*

Often, isolation seems to be the solution in times of distress. We withdraw, convinced that being alone will protect us or make the weight easier to carry. Yet Scripture calls us to do the exact opposite. Isolation is not where healing happens. In fact, it is often the very place where discouragement deepens, and hope begins to fade.

God designed us for community because He knows we are stronger together. Fellowship pulls us out of the dark places we tend to retreat to when life feels overwhelming. When we stumble, community lifts us. When our faith feels weak, others help remind us of truth. God frequently uses people to bring encouragement, correction, and restoration into our lives.

As we continue these 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting, let us choose connection over isolation. Let's root ourselves in godly fellowship, allowing others to walk with us, pray with us, and hold us accountable to live according to God's will. We were never meant to walk this journey alone.
