day eighteen:

draw near

“Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.” James 4:8

God’s invitation has always been closeness. He does not stand at a distance waiting for us to get everything right first; He simply asks us to come.

To draw near is an intentional step, a quiet turning of our hearts toward Him in honesty and humility. Even when we feel unworthy or distracted, His promise remains that when we move toward Him, He moves toward us.

Drawing near often requires letting go of divided hearts and hidden compromises. It means allowing God to cleanse what has become cluttered and to purify what has been pulled in too many directions. This is not about perfection, but about sincerity. God honors a heart that is willing to be real before Him.

As we continue these 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting, let us choose closeness over distance.

In moments of weakness, confusion, or longing, take a step toward Him. He is faithful to meet us there, ready to restore, renew, and remind us that His presence is where we were always meant to be.
