A LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR KYLE MCMULLEN



In With the Old Breed, WWII Marine veteran E.B. Sledge recounts his personal experience fighting in the battles of Peleliu and Okinawa. His poweful narrative provides a first-hand depiction of the grueling and brutal nature of war.

Sledge originally planned to enter the Marines by way of college. Upon graduating from the ROTC program, he would have gone in as an officer. But WWII was in full-swing and he and several other recruits felt compelled to get to the front lines faster. Having already been sworn in, there was only one way to do this: intentionally flunk out and then go in as enlisted men. This is exactly what they did. As they were leaving, one of their commanding officers told them off record that they had the spirit of true Marines. Rather than wait in the safety of college for 4 years, they chose to go where the bullets were flying.

E.B. Sledge entered boot camp, went through field training, and was fully immersed in the war within months. Throughout his book, he pauses his combat narrative to comment on the high-quality training he received in boot camp. In the thick of battle, it became clear to Sledge that he truly had been prepared, as much as any man could be, for the incomparable stress of war.

CURRICULUM

BIBLE

Brace yourself, we're living in a post-Christian, post common sense culture—a world that is fundamentally at odds with the faith you profess. How did we get here? Well, it's a long story...a story that began to unfold early in the book of Genesis with a plot that has found its way into every storyline since then: a people who must be rescued from a dragon that must be slain. Seeing how God views the world is the pathway to success in life. If you don't know your Bible, forget whatever skill set you have—your life will be overtaken by a dragon that's been hunting down people for thousands of years.

FALL TERM Bible Study Methods & Pentateuch

This class lays a crucial foundation for knowing how to read and interpret the Bible. It then explores the first five books of the Bible, the foundation of the grand metanarrative of God's Word. You will gain an understanding of literary genres in the Bible and survey the Pentateuch with a strong focus on Biblical Theology.

WINTER TERM Prophets & Writings

This class surveys the Old Testament Prophets and Writings—these are the biblical books referred to as the Histories, Prophets, and Wisdom Literature. You will practice doing Biblical Theology through various assignments and presentations.

SPRING TERM New Testament

In this culminating Bible class of the Vector program, you will survey the entire New Testament. The New Testament authors were the ultimate biblical theologians, building on the foundation of the Old Testament and expounding the Gospel of Jesus Christ through captivating narrative and profound prose.

DOCTRINE

Doctrine is not a dry document on the wall of a museum. It is a map that reveals the adventure of following Jesus. Theology is the ministry of reality; it opens our eyes to see things the way they are, igniting our imagination to live courageously and faithfully in God's world.

FALL TERM God Speaks

In this class, you will discover that faithful discipleship requires doctrine. Theology begins with God the Father, the Creator of Heaven and Earth. His revelation of Himself to us is the only real foundation of knowledge. You will learn the Doctrines of Revelation, Scripture, God and His Attributes, the Trinity, and Creation.

WINTER TERM God Redeems

Building on the theme that doctrine and discipleship are companions, you will gain a practical understanding of mankind, sin, and salvation. The theological focus is now on God the Son, Jesus Christ, who is Savior and Lord. You will learn the Doctrines of Man, Sin, Angels and Demons, Christ, Atonement, and Salvation.

SPRING TERM God Sends

In this final Doctrine class, you will be equipped to live as a Spirit-filled believer. The emphasis moves to God the Holy Spirit. You will learn the Doctrines of the Holy Spirit, Sanctification, the Church, Heaven and Hell, and End Times.



CHRISTIANITY & CULTURE

This course is a journey through the ages, from the Ancient Greeks right up to our modern times. Students will read widely from great texts of the West and be able to trace trends through the centuries. Psalm 24 tells us that "the earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof," and culture is no exception to the domain of King Jesus' lordship. This course provides vital preparation for future leaders, equipping them to understand the times and shape culture.

FALL TERM Great Ideas of the West

Long before the Pioneers, Pilgrims, and Puritans, the seeds of Western Civilization were planted by the Ancients. To understand our modern age, we need a history of the ages. This class is a survey of Western thought. You will be amazed by the powerful influence that ideas can have—even really old ones. This class gives you a foundation for understanding culture.

WINTER TERM God, Government, and American Civics

What is government? What do politics have to do with faith? This class focuses on the history of American government and the influence of Christianity. You will study foundational American documents like the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution. This class prepares you to think and act biblically as a Christian and citizen.

SPRING TERM Understanding the Times

This capstone Christianity & Culture class faces the hot button cultural issues of our day head-on and gives students the opportunity to practice critiquing culture through the lens of biblical truth. Through reading, presentations, and debate, you will learn how to think on your feet and articulate truth. Leaders have to know how to communicate and persuade. This class will prepare you for just that.

APOLOGETICS

Apologetics has been defined as "defending the Christian faith," but it's really much more than that; it is embodied theology. Apologetics is the art of interpreting reality through the lens of God's truth. It is the expression, not just of truth, but of the goodness and beauty that comes with it. The Christian worldview speaks for itself when it is displayed well through conversations, questions, answers, listening, challenging, and engaging.

FALL TERM Worldview

In this introduction to Apologetics, you will learn the components of worldviews and belief systems. Every person presupposes a way of viewing the world that governs everything he does. This class explores various prevalent worldviews that are opposed to Christianity. You will be equipped to understand opposing belief systems and be trained in how to critique and refute them with the light of God's Word.

WINTER TERM Apologetics

Apologetics is one of the most exciting disciplines of Christian Theology. We are commanded by the Apostle Peter to "be ready to give an answer for the hope that we have." How do we cultivate this readiness? This class is a rigorous and engaging training that prepares you to bring the Christian worldview into real life relationships and conversations.

SPRING TERM The Life and Thoughts of C.S. Lewis

This culminating class of the Apologetics curriculum is a deep dive into the writings of one of the greatest thinkers in the history of the Church. C.S. Lewis was masterful, whether he was writing children's fantasy, sophisticated sci-fi, devotional reflections, or studious theology. He did all of it with remarkable skill. The beauty of the Christian worldview permeates through everything Lewis wrote. This class is nothing short of a rollicking good time.

CHARACTER & LEADERSHIP

Integrity is where the chasm between belief and action dissolves. This is the lifelong journey of sanctification. Every person who repents and believes in Jesus embarks on the adventure of dying to sin in exchange for the transformed life of righteousness. The love of God compels us toward obedience, and His grace sustains us when we fail. We believe in the empowering work of the Holy Spirit and the reality of experiencing new life in Christ.

FALL TERM Practical Discipleship

In this class, you will learn and develop spiritual disciplines. You will not only discover the biblical basis for these disciplines, you will be given opportunities to practice them. A thriving relationship with Christ is the bedrock of your character. This class helps you get the important things right.

WINTER TERM Life Vision & Stewardship

Do you know where your life is going? Have you charted a course for faithfulness and fruitfulness? This class gives you practical tools for making a life plan. This is an exercise that you will be able to use for the rest of your life. Additionally, you will learn the importance of stewardship with a special focus on biblical wisdom for managing money.

SPRING TERM Practical Theology of Vocation

Every Christian has been called by God. How does this calling impact our work, relationships, and roles? The success of your leadership is determined by your humility and dependence on Christ. In this class, you will gain confidence in your calling, understand biblical manhood and womanhood, learn to trust the Holy Spirit, and deepen your conviction that God is sovereign over the specific details of your life.
