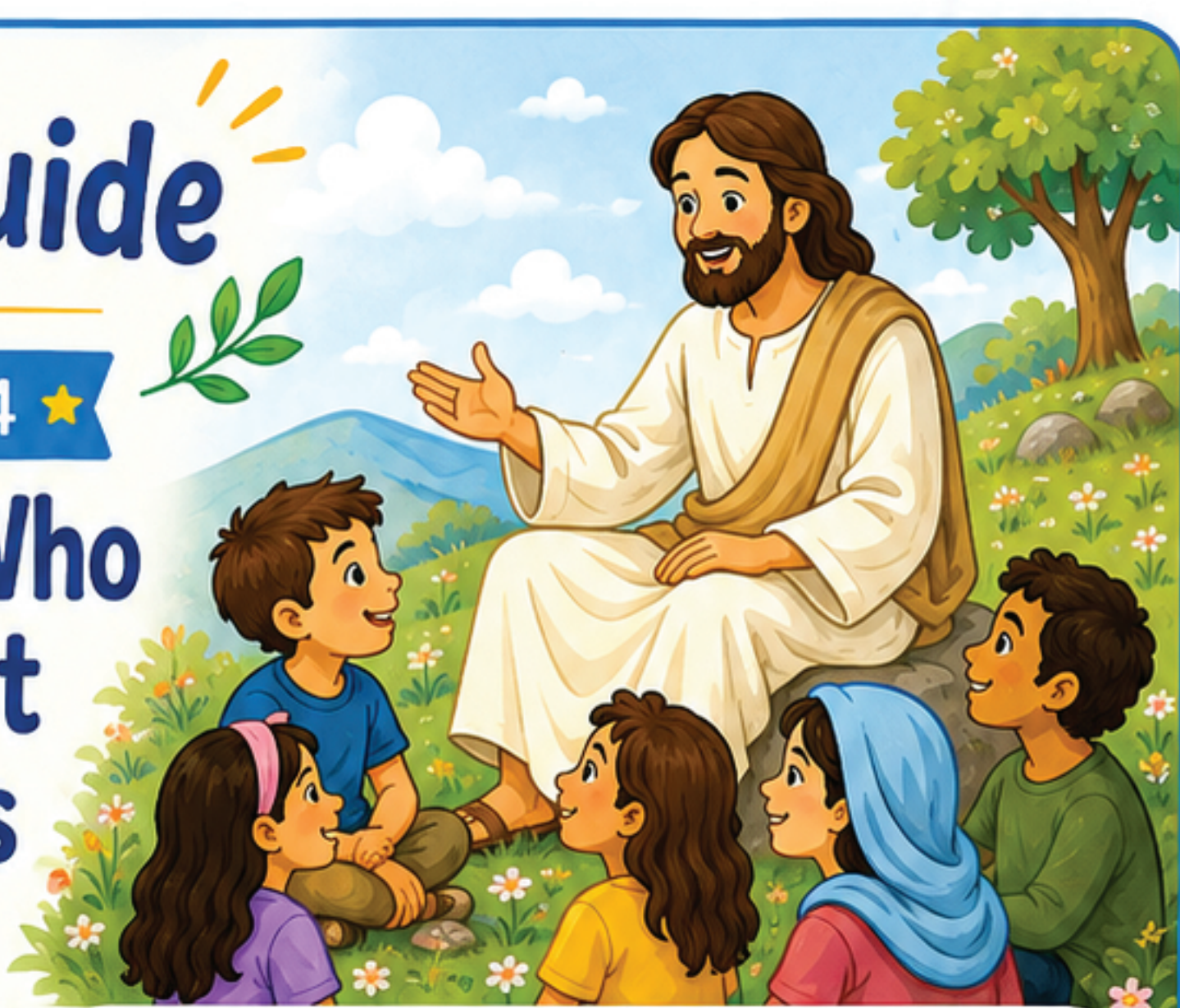

Big Truth

Jesus wants me to want
what is right more than
anything else. When I seek
Him first, He fills my heart.



Kingdom Steps

1. Poor in spirit — I need God.
2. Those who mourn — I am sorry for sin.
3. The meek — I let God lead me.
4. Hunger and thirst for righteousness — I want what pleases God.



What Does 'Hunger and Thirst for Righteousness' Mean?

- It means I want to live God's way.
- I want my heart to be more like Jesus.
- I want what is true, good, and right.
- Jesus is better than the things the world offers.



Bible Examples

- **David** — "My soul thirsts for You."
- **Paul** — wanted Jesus more than everything else.
- **The Woman at the Well** — Jesus gives living water.
- **Jesus** — always loved what pleased His Father.
