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## March 15-16 – Depart & Arrive in the Land of Israel

Your journey begins as you depart from the USA on an overnight flight. Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport (Tel Aviv), you will be warmly greeted by our representative and transferred to your hotel in Netanya, overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. Enjoy dinner and rest as you prepare to walk the Land of the Bible.

**Overnight: Netanya**

## March 17 – Caesarea by the Sea, Mount Carmel, Megiddo & Ein Harod (Gideon's Spring)

Begin at Caesarea Maritima, where Shaul (Paul) was imprisoned (Acts 23:33 TLV) and Cornelius, a Roman centurion, became one of the first non-Jewish believers (Acts 10 TLV). Ascend Mount Carmel, where Eliyahu (Elijah), confronted the prophets of Baal and called down fire from heaven (1 Kings 18 TLV). Continue to Tel Megiddo, overlooking the Jezreel Valley—biblical Har Megiddo, where the Scriptures foretell the final gathering of nations (Revelation 16:16 TLV). Conclude at Nazareth Village, a living reconstruction of first-century life that brings the boyhood home of Yeshua (Jesus) into vivid reality (Matthew 2:23). In the evening, join together for a joyful Erev Shabbat Dinner—Israel-style—welcoming the Sabbath in the Galilee.

## March 18 – The Galilee of Yeshua

Travel the Valley of the Doves below Mount Arbel (Isaiah 9:1-2 TLV), the ancient route Yeshua (Jesus) and His disciples used throughout Galilee. Visit Magdala, hometown of Miriam of Magdala (Mary Magdalene), and see the first-century synagogue where Yeshua may have taught. Enjoy a special boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, with a time of Praise and Thanksgiving to the God of Israel in worship and reflection. At Kibbutz Nof Ginosar, view the 2,000-year-old Galilee Boat, dating to the time of Yeshua. Visit Capernaum, the town where Yeshua taught in the synagogue and performed many miracles (Matthew 4:13, 23 TLV). Conclude on the Mount of Beatitudes, reflecting on Yeshua's words (Matthew 5-7 TLV).

## March 19 – Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Golan Heights & Jordan River

At Tel Dan, see the altar built by King Jeroboam (1 Kings 12:25-30 TLV) and the inscription referencing the "House of David." Continue to Caesarea Philippi, where Shimon Kefa (Simon Peter) declared to Yeshua, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:16 TLV). Drive along the Golan Heights, taking in views of Syria, Jordan, and the northern landscape of Israel.

**Overnight: Galilee**

## March 20 – Beit She'an, Masada, Ein Gedi & Dead Sea

Start the day in Beit She'an, a city continuously inhabited for over 5,000 years. The uncovered ruins date back to the Greek/Roman city that was part of the Decapolis during Yeshua's day. See colonnaded streets with marble sidewalks, Roman public baths, and a theater. Journey south through the Judean wilderness to Masada, Herod's mountain fortress and the final stand of Jewish zealots against Rome. Continue to Ein Gedi, the desert oasis where King David hid from King Shaul (1 Samuel 24 TLV). Enjoy a relaxing float in the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, and marvel at the beauty of the Judean Desert.

**Overnight: Jerusalem**

## March 21 – Israel Museum, Yad Vashem, Temple Institute & Western Wall Tunnels

Begin at the Israel Museum, home to the Shrine of the Book (housing the Dead Sea Scrolls, including the Isaiah Scroll, and the Second Temple Model of Jerusalem. Continue to Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust Memorial, honoring the memory of the six million and the faithfulness of G-d's people. After lunch and some time to shop in the Cardo, visit the Temple Institute, dedicated to preparing for the rebuilding of the Holy Temple, and view reconstructed sacred vessels. Mount Zion to see the traditional site of the Upper Room (Mark 14:12-26), and see the traditional tomb of King David.

**Overnight: Jerusalem**

## March 22 – Samaria – Shiloh, Mountains of Blessing, Curses, and Covenants & Festival of Purim

Travel north through Samaria, passing Tel Dothan, where Joseph was betrayed by his brothers (Genesis 37:17-28). Visit Samaria, the former capital of the northern kingdom (1 Kings 16:28-30). Continue to Ancient Shiloh, the spiritual center of Israel for nearly 400 years, where the Tabernacle once stood and where the Ark of the Covenant rested during the period of the Judges (Joshua 18:1; 1 Samuel 1-4). Here Hannah prayed for a son, and young Samuel first heard the Lord's voice. You will also have the unique opportunity to see the Red Heifers, a modern point of interest connected to biblical purity laws and priest/temple dedication (Numbers 19:1-10). See Mount Ebal and Mount Gerizim, where Moses commanded Israel to proclaim blessings and curses (Deuteronomy 11:29; Joshua 8:30-35). View the excavations of Joshua's Altar (Joshua 8:30), then continue to Nablus (ancient Shechem) to visit Jacob's Well, where Yeshua spoke to the Samaritan woman (John 4:5-14). In the evening, welcome the Festival of Purim by taking a walk through the streets of Jerusalem!

**Overnight: Jerusalem**

## March 23 – Teaching Steps, City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Pool of Siloam, Mount of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane & Empty Tomb

Begin the morning by ascending to the Temple Mount. Then explore the City of David, Jerusalem's oldest section, and walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel to the Pool of Siloam, where Yeshua healed the man born blind (John 9 TLV). Ascend the newly excavated Pilgrim Road to the Teaching Steps of the ancient Temple, where Yeshua likely taught His disciples. Spend time at the Western Wall, a place of prayer and connection for all of Israel. In the afternoon, visit the Mount of Olives (Zechariah 14:4 TLV), the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:36 TLV), and the Pool of Bethesda (John 5:2 TLV). Then visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre the traditional site venerated as the place of Yeshua's Death, Burial & Resurrection, or spend some time shopping. Conclude at the Garden Tomb for a time of the Messiah's Yizkor (Communion) (Luke 24:6 TLV). After dinner, have time to pack and refresh before you transfer to the airport for your overnight flight (unless you select the extension).

## March 24 – Return to the USA or Enjoy an Extension

Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for your return flight to the United States, carrying home memories of a lifetime walking in the Land of the Bible.

### March 24 – Free Day

Enjoy a free day in Jerusalem to explore on your own, or just relax at your hotel.

### March 25 – Jerash

This morning, you will journey across the Allenby Bridge on your way to Jerash, one of the best-preserved Roman cities in the world. Stroll through the oval piazza and wander along colonnaded streets etched by the wheels of ancient chariots. Stand in the grand theater where an onstage whisper can be heard in the top row. Continue to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

### March 26 – Madaba & Mount Nebo

Begin your journey south towards Petra today. Stop in Madaba, the City of Mosaics, to visit the Church of Saint George with its sixth-century Byzantine mosaic map showing Jerusalem and other holy sites. Continue to Mount Nebo, where Moses caught a glimpse of the Promised Land (Deut. 34). On a clear day, you can see all the way across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea to the rooftops

of Jerusalem and Bethlehem. End your day at the shore of the Dead Sea and check into your hotel.

### March 27 – Petra

Explore the city of Petra. Its entrance passes through a long, narrow gorge known as the Siq and can only be accessed by carriage, horseback, or on foot. Once inside the city, marvel at the intricate detail of a city that was cut into the cliffsides of rose-colored rock. Return to your hotel at the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight.

### March 28 – Free Morning at the Dead Sea

Enjoy a free morning at your hotel. Cross the border back into Israel and enjoy dinner in Jerusalem. Afterward, you will travel to the airport in Tel Aviv to begin your journey home.

### March 24 – Free Day

Enjoy a day at leisure in Jerusalem. Explore the ancient city on your own or rest at the hotel. Breakfast and dinner are included in your hotel stay.

### March 25 – Jerusalem to Mount Sinai

Travel in the footsteps of the Holy Family as you travel along the ancient caravan route from Jerusalem to the Sinai Desert. Cross the border and check into your hotel near Mount Sinai for dinner and rest.

### March 26 – St. Catherine's Monastery / Optional Mount Sinai Climb

Even Muhammad found refuge here, and the site is sacred to all three monotheistic religions. Remember the story of Moses and the burning bush, which tradition places inside the monastery. Continue to Sharm el Sheikh for dinner and overnight at your hotel located on the shores of the Red Sea.

### March 27 – Route of the Exodus

Enjoy a relaxing morning before traveling to Cairo for dinner and your overnight stay.

### March 28 – Cairo

This morning, visit the Grand Egyptian Museum, which holds 7,000 years of Egyptian history and includes the world-famous golden treasures from King Tutankhamun's tomb. After, you will visit the Great Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

### March 29 – Memphis, Saqqara, the Great Pyramids & the Sphinx

Travel, as Abraham did, to Memphis (Biblical Noph) and on to Saqqara, where you will see the Step Pyramid, the world's oldest stone structure. Enjoy an afternoon felucca ride. Enjoy dinner at your hotel and prepare for your flight home.
