Today’s Scripture

Romans 10:1-13 ESV

¹⁰ Brothers,^[a] my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. ²For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. ³For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. ⁴For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.^[b]

⁵For Moses writes about the righteousness that is based on the law, that the person who does the commandments shall live by them. ⁶But the righteousness based on faith says, “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’” (that is, to bring Christ down) ⁷“or ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’” (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). ⁸But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim); ⁹because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. ¹¹For the Scripture says, “Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame.” ¹²For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. ¹³For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

The Lord be with you.

It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

blood of the new covenant, poured out for you
and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this,
as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

And so, to remember Your mighty acts in Jesus
Christ, we offer ourselves in praise and
thanksgiving as a holy and living sacrifice, in
union with Christ's offering for us, as we proclaim
the mystery of faith.

**Christ has died; Christ is risen;
Christ will come again.**

Pour out Your Holy Spirit on us and on these gifts
of bread and wine. Make them be for us the
body and blood of Christ, that we may be the
body of Christ, redeemed by His blood. By your
Spirit make us one with Christ, one with each
other, and one in ministry to the world, until
Christ comes in final victory, and we feast at his
heavenly banquet. Through your Son Jesus
Christ, with the Holy Spirit in your holy Church,
all honor and glory is Yours, Almighty Father,
now and forever more. Amen.
