The Gospel: Good. God. Gospel. (Part 2) - John 4:1-29

1 Peter 3:15 but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect.

1. John 4:28–29 — The Samaritan woman immediately went and told others, “Come, see...” What has Jesus done in your life that you could naturally share with someone right now?

2. Matthew 28:18–20 — Jesus commands us to go and make disciples. How do you personally respond to the idea that evangelism is not optional? Where do you feel resistance?

3. 1 Peter 3:15 — We are called to share with gentleness and respect. Have you ever seen the gospel shared in a way that lacked this? How did it affect you or others?

4. The sermon emphasized not treating people like projects. Looking at John 4, how did Jesus build relationship before speaking truth? What would it look like for you to follow that pattern this week?

5. Colossians 4:5–6 talks about walking in wisdom and recognizing opportunities. Where might God already be opening a “window” for a spiritual conversation in your current relationships?

6. Romans 1:16 says the gospel is the power of God for salvation. Where are you tempted to rely on your own words, personality, or timing instead of trusting the power of the gospel itself?

7. Think about the full gospel from last week (Creation, Fall, Works, Jesus, Cross, Resurrection, Salvation, Return). Which part do you tend to leave out when talking about Jesus, and how might that limit someone’s understanding of the gospel?
