



Galatians: Guarding the Truth – Galatians 2:1-10

Memory Verse: Galatians 2:5 “We did not yield in submission even for a moment, so that the truth of the gospel might be preserved for you.”

1. Where are you most tempted to add something to Jesus in order to feel accepted by God?
2. Do you usually obey God because you know you are accepted, or because you are trying to earn His acceptance? What does that reveal?
3. Paul refused to compromise the gospel, even for a moment. Is there an area where you have remained silent or unclear because you wanted to avoid tension?
4. Are there convictions, traditions, or preferences that you sometimes treat as though every faithful Christian must share them?
5. Do you ever compare your calling, gifting, or ministry to someone else's? How does that affect the way you serve?
6. The gospel produces compassion for people in need. Has receiving God's grace made you more generous and attentive to others? Where do you still need to grow?
7. What is one practical way you can guard the truth of the gospel while also pursuing unity and compassion this week?
