



## So So So So So So Good To Me (Kids Takeover Weekend) – Psalm 107:1

Memory Verse Psalm 107:1 — “Give thanks to the Lord, because he is good. His faithful love continues forever.”

1. Jesus said we must “become like little children” (Matthew 18:1-5). What qualities of a child do you think Jesus wants His followers to have? Which of those qualities do you need to grow in?
2. Which of the six reminders of God’s goodness spoke to you most this week? God keeps His promises, God teaches us, God helps us, God saves us, God works with us, God is good because that is who He is. Why did that truth stand out to you?
3. Think about a time when God kept one of His promises or helped you through a difficult season. How has that experience strengthened your faith?
4. Peter began to sink when he took his eyes off Jesus, but Jesus immediately reached out to help him (Matthew 14). Where do you need to trust Jesus instead of your own strength right now?
5. Jesus has invited every believer to join Him in His mission (Matthew 28:19-20). How is God calling you to participate in His work this week, whether at home, at work, at school, or in your neighborhood?
6. God’s goodness is rooted in His unchanging character, not in our circumstances (Psalm 100:5). Why is it important to remember this when life is difficult?
7. Looking back over the past year, where have you seen God’s goodness most clearly? Take time as a group or family to thank Him together.
