This is called **positional** membership.

The Bible urges believers to continue growing by becoming **participating** members of a specific local church through active involvement in building that church body as seen in Romans 12:4-8, 1 Corinthians 12:12-31, 14:12, and Hebrews 10:24-25.

TIMELINE

MARCH 2006

ORIGINALLY CALLED SOUTH LEE COUNTY METHODIST CHURCH, OFFICIALLY LAUNCHED ON MARCH 5, 2006 WITH PASTOR BRYAN GERSTEL AS THE FOUNDING PASTOR. A CHURCH PLANT FROM PORTERFIELD AND ALBANY FIRST UMC.

2006 - JANUARY 2007

THE CHURCH LAUNCHED AND WAS QUICKLY REFERRED TO AS THE CONTEMPORARY PORTABLE CHURCH WITH A NEW NAME OF THE POINTE UMC AND NICKNAMED THE CHURCH AT THE ZOO AS CHEHAW PARK WAS THE FIRST MEETING PLACE. THE POINTE CONTINUED GROWING AND MET AT THE LOCAL MOVIE THEATER.

JUNE 2012

THE FIRST PASTORAL TRANSITION BEGAN IN JUNE OF 2012 WITH AN INTERIM PASTOR SERVING BEFORE PASTOR CARL BARNHARDT BEGAN.

2015

A MAJOR RENOVATION WAS DONE ON THE BUILDING ON CEDRIC STREET WHERE THE STAGE WAS MOVED, NEW AIR CONDITIONING INSTALLED, AND FLOODING ISSUES RESOLVED.

2022

ANOTHER PASTORAL TRANSITION WOULD BEGIN AS CARL RETIRED. BIBLICAL ISSUES WITHIN THE METHODIST DENOMINATION STARTED THE NEED TO DISAFFILIATE. ONCE THE DISAFFILIATION WAS COMPLETED, A NEW NON-DENOMINATIONAL CHURCH CALLED THE POINTE OF LEE COUNTY WAS FORMED.

2022-2023

PASTOR CHRIS CARTER BEGAN IN THE END OF 2022 AND LEFT IN MAY OF 2023.

THE PASTORAL SEARCH COMMITTEE RESTARTED ANOTHER SEARCH AND GOD BROUGHT PASTOR SAM HALL AND HIS FAMILY FROM WISCONSIN TO PASTOR.

2024

WITH A NEW PASTOR IN PLACE, THE POINTE OF LEE COUNTY WAS RENAMED AS ROCK CREEK CHURCH AS THE FINAL STEP IN THE DISAFFILIATION PROCESS.

2025

SINCE RENAMING, RCC HAS CONTINUED TO GROW IN MANY AREAS, INCLUDING BECOMING DEBT FREE IN NOVEMBER.

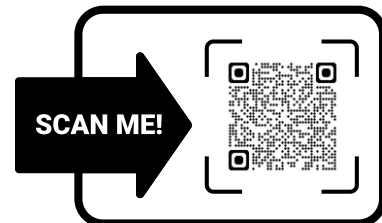

SANCTITY OF LIFE

OUR STRUCTURE

Rock Creek Church is an autonomous church, meaning we are not part of a denomination or affiliated with another governing authority. Our church is non-denominational and we are self-governing.

PASTOR-LED

The role of a pastor in the Bible is compared to that of a "shepherd." A major part of what shepherds do is to lead their sheep to food, safety, and new places. So, as shepherds, the leadership of the local church is a huge part of what pastors are called to do. However, pastors are called to follow Jesus' example and lead as servant leaders. Pastors serve the local church primarily by leading them to obey God's Word. A pastor's only source of authority is God's Word. He is responsible to God to guide the local church to obey God's Word in every way.

ELDERS

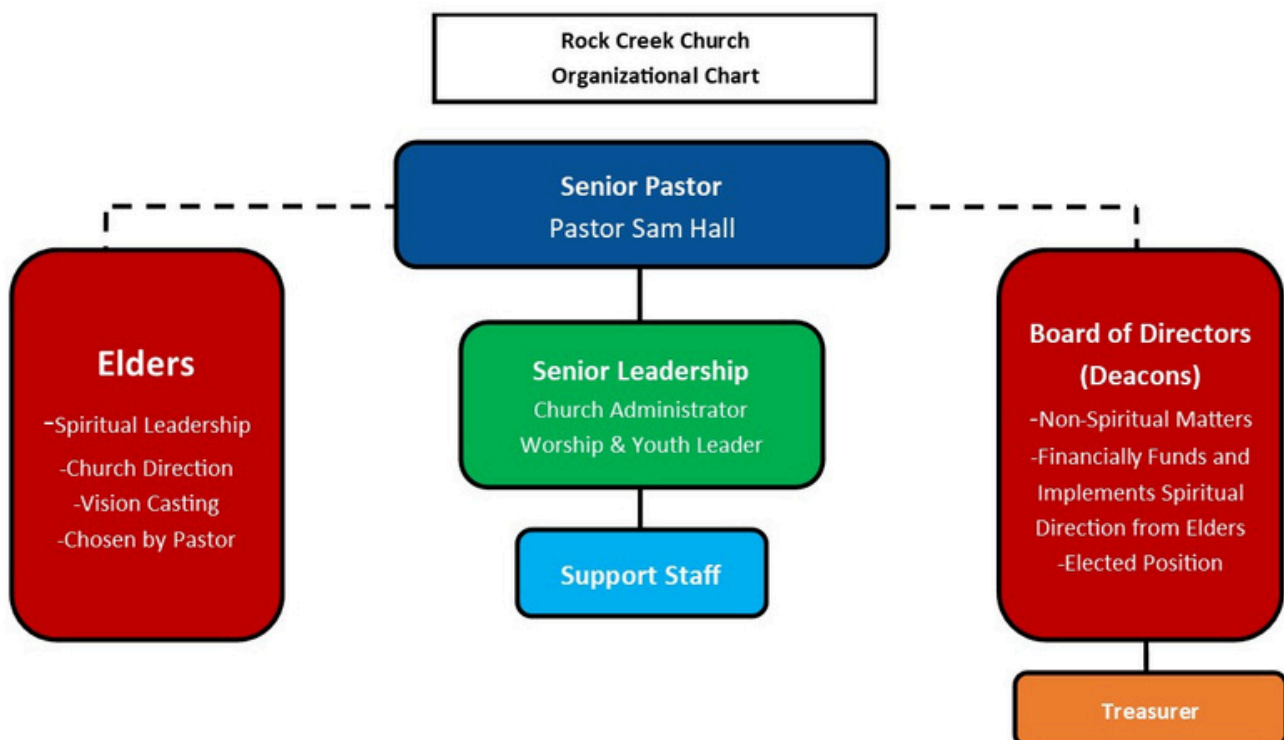
Elders are appointed by the Senior Pastor and help the Senior Pastor with spiritual leadership of the church, casting vision, and overall church direction. Once appointed by the Senior Pastor, the Elders do not have a term expiration and serve for the term of the Senior Pastor.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS/DEACONS

The Board of Directors are nominated by the Senior Pastor and Elders and brought to the membership for election annually if a vacancy is open. The Board of Directors serves as a Deacon role, offering guidance in non-spiritual matters. They help serve by implementing the spiritual direction casted by the Elders. Board of Directors serve a two-year term with the ability to serve three successive terms before needing to take a year off from service.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF MEMBERS?

THE PURPOSE

The main responsibilities of participating members of Rock Creek Church are to live with Christ as the center of your life, be relationally connected in the church, develop a contagious lifestyle of sharing God's love with others, contribute to the growth and effectiveness of the church by serving according to your spiritual gifts and by faithful financial stewardship and giving, and celebrate regularly in weekly worship at Rock Creek Church.

NOT PERFECTION

Let's be clear: We don't expect perfection from any of our members. All of us, are works in progress, and are never immune to mistakes, slips, and sin. By becoming a participating member of Rock Creek, you are not being asked to commit to an unattainable standard, but are simply saying that with God's help, you intend to seek ongoing personal development as a follower of Jesus. God never commands us to do anything that he will not enable us to do in His strength.

THE PRIVILEGES

If you desire to grow in your walk with Christ through participatory membership, there are privileges that come alongside membership. You have the opportunity to influence key decisions of the church, including major ministry direction, election of board of directors, and financial decisions. Certain leadership positions in the church, such as an Elder or Board of Director, require participating membership.

However, the main reason of membership is not to gain personal advantage, but to identify with a particular local church for the sake of pursuing spiritual maturity and serving Christ.

LIVING OUT MEMBERSHIP

We are a Church Family that serves together. When each member loves, serves, and commits to one another, we can more fully demonstrate and declare the Gospel to others.
