

Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost?

There is a per-family registration fee of \$50 a semester. This covers classroom supplies and curriculum. The church graciously assists with facilities & childcare.

How do I sign-up?

An application for the upcoming year will be added to the church's website at foothillscp.org/homeschool. Once we review your application, we will contact you with more information.

Is there really childcare?

Yes! In order to ensure the co-op is available to those with small children, childcare is provided for 0-2 year olds. 3 years old and up are invited to participate in our classes.

What classes are taught?

We offer a variety of classes and topics each semester that vary. The directors work with parent teachers to pick topics for each age group for each of the two periods. In the past we have taught classes in the following topics: ecology, art, astronomy, beginning Spanish, American westward expansion, and so on.

What will mom time look like?

This time is set aside to be an intentional time for homeschool mamas to connect and support one another on our homeschool journeys. It will incorporate structured conversations and prayer.

Do parents have to teach? Can I drop-off my kids?

Parents must stay on campus and participate in a classroom and attend mom time. We work with you to find where you are most comfortable serving in a classroom.

What safety measures are in place?

Every parent must complete the church's safe place training, background check and fingerprinting. A minimum of two adults will be present in each class.
