(e.g. Questions you have about the text; things you have never noticed before; things you have been reminded of that are important; repeated or key words, phrases, concepts, etc.; important concepts/ideas used outside of Romans; things that impressed you; something you learned about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit; something you learned about yourself from the text; etc.)

2. What scripture(s) does Paul quote in verse 6, and what point is he making by his use of it in this context?
3. What key points is Paul making about “the Law” in vv. 12-16?
4. What things does Paul note that a Jew might boast about in vv. 17-29?
5. What key points is Paul making to the “Jew” in vv. 17-29?
6. What scripture does Paul quote in vv. 17-29 and how does it contribute to Paul’s point in this section?
7. What key points is Paul making about the Gentile in vv. 17-29?
8. Let’s apply this chapter to us today. What lesson(s) do you learn about judgment for your life?
9. How does Paul’s message about “boasting” apply to us today, and more specifically to your life?
