# OUR LITURGY

## CONNECT

— 10 MINUTES

When you hear the word “revival” what comes to mind?  
Have you ever experienced a season where your faith felt especially alive? What contributed to that?  
Why do you think people sometimes describe church or faith as dry, dull, or boring?

## REVIEW

— 30 MINUTES

**Read:** Acts 1:4-5 and Acts 2:1-13

- What stood out to you most from the Pentecost story?
- What differences do you notice between Peter before and after being baptized in the Holy Spirit?
- People heard the message in their own heart language— what does this reveal about the heart of God?
- Who in your life needs to hear the good news of Jesus in a way they can truly understand and receive?

**Read:** Acts 2:14-21; 37-41

- What would have been shocking about this to the original audience?
- How does this challenge your ideas about only super spiritual people being used by God?
- What examples do we see today of God still pouring out His Spirit?
- How does the “great and glorious day of the Lord” motivate us toward mission and evangelism (or does it at all)?
- How did Peter’s preaching impact the crowd?
- How does this compare to your efforts to share the gospel?

**Read:** 1 Thessalonians 5:19 and Ephesians 5:18-19

- How do these two responses to the Holy Spirit compare to your life?



- Why do you think some Christians feel hesitant or nervous about this topic?
- How can we stay grounded in the Scripture while remaining open to the Spirits work?

## APPLICATION

– 30 MINUTES

**Read:** Luke 11:9-13

- Spend time every day this week asking the Holy Spirit to fill and lead you.
- Repent of any ways you recognize you have quenched the spirit.
- Pray for boldness in witnessing to others.
- Make a list of ten people far from Jesus that you will pray for regularly.
