Prism Project is a nonprofit organization with a two-fold mission: preventing child exploitation through education and providing restorative, trauma-informed care for child survivors of human trafficking through Michigan's first long-term Safehouse Program. For the past three years, Prism Project's Safehouse has provided a place where girls ages 12-17 can begin rebuilding their lives in an environment centered on safety, healing, consistency, and hope. During this special evening, bringing together local churches and ministry partners, you'll learn about the impact of the Safehouse Program, hear the vision for their Schoolhouse & Church transformation project, discover meaningful ways to partner with Prism Project—including volunteer opportunities for individuals and teams—and see how your support can help change the lives of children impacted by human trafficking.

An offering will be taken at the end of the evening and the Fenton UMC endowment fund will match the offering.
