Bible Story

Supplies Needed: Bible Story Pictures (provided on pg. 5-8)

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Pictures. Have the children gathered around so they can see the pictures.

Say- Philip, one of Jesus’ twelve disciples, was walking along the road when (*show pic*) he saw a court official from the country of Ethiopia sitting in his chariot.

Say- The Holy Spirit spoke to Philip and told him to go over to the chariot. Of course, Philip obeyed!

Say- The Ethiopian man was reading the writings of the prophet Isaiah, which are now found in the Bible. (*show pic*) So Philip asked the man, “Do you understand what you are reading?”

Say- The Ethiopian man said he didn’t understand and asked Philip to teach him. So that is exactly what Philip did. For hours, he told the man all about Jesus and how He died on the cross to forgive the sins of the world.

Say- The Ethiopian man believed and became a Christian right there in the chariot!

Say- Not far down the road, they came across some water. The man spoke to Philip, (*show pic*) “Look! Here’s some water! Why can’t I be baptized?”

Say- Philip took the Ethiopian man down to the water and (*show pic*) baptized him. They were both so full of JOY!

Hands-On Learning

Supplies Needed: Money; globe

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, gather classroom materials. Have the children gathered around so they can see any illustration materials.

Say- Did you know there are SO MANY people who have never heard of Jesus? It's true! That's why we've been talking about MISSIONS!

Ask- What is missions?

-Allow time for response-

Say- Missions is telling others about Jesus! Let's say that together: "Missions is telling others about Jesus!" (Say the phrase aloud with the kids)

Say- There are people who live close by, right in our neighborhoods, who may not know Jesus. And there are people who live far, far away in other places who haven't heard about Jesus either!

Ask- Who should tell people about Jesus?

-Allow time for response-

Say- EVERY Christian should tell people about Jesus! That means you and me!

Say- Now, there are three special ways you can help share Jesus' love with others. We learned the first two. Let's see if we can remember what they were.

Say- First, you can PRAY! (Place your hands together like you're praying) Let's all say "Pray" together! (Do the motion and say the word aloud with the kids)

Say- You can pray for people to know Jesus, and for missionaries who are telling others about Him.

Say- Second, you can GIVE! (Hold up the money) Let's say "Give" together! (Say the word aloud with the kids)

Say- You can give money to help missionaries tell more people about Jesus.

Say- Now let's learn the third way...you can GO! (Stand up and run in place) Let's say "Go" together! (Do the motion and say the word aloud with the kids)

Say- You can go and tell people about Jesus! Remember, you're never too young to start telling people about Jesus! You can pray, give, and go!

Say- Say this with me: I will tell about Jesus everywhere I go! (Say the phrase aloud with the kids)



Craft #1: Bible Story Coloring Page

Supplies Needed: Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 9); Crayons or markers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece. Make sure you have enough for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for coloring.

How To Do Craft - Kids can color freely as they choose.



Craft #2: World Heart Craft

Supplies Needed: World Heart Craft Print Piece (provided on pg. 10); Crayons or Markers; Heart Stickers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the World Heart Craft Print Pieces. Make sure you have enough craft pages for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for crafting.

How To Do Craft - Allow the kids to decorate the page and place heart stickers on the dotted outlines. As you help the kids with the craft, talk about how they can GO and tell people about Jesus!



Craft #3: Tell About Jesus Coloring Page

Supplies Needed: Tell About Jesus Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 11); Crayons or markers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Tell About Jesus Coloring Page Print Pieces. Make sure you have enough for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for coloring.

How To Do Craft - Kids can color freely as they choose.



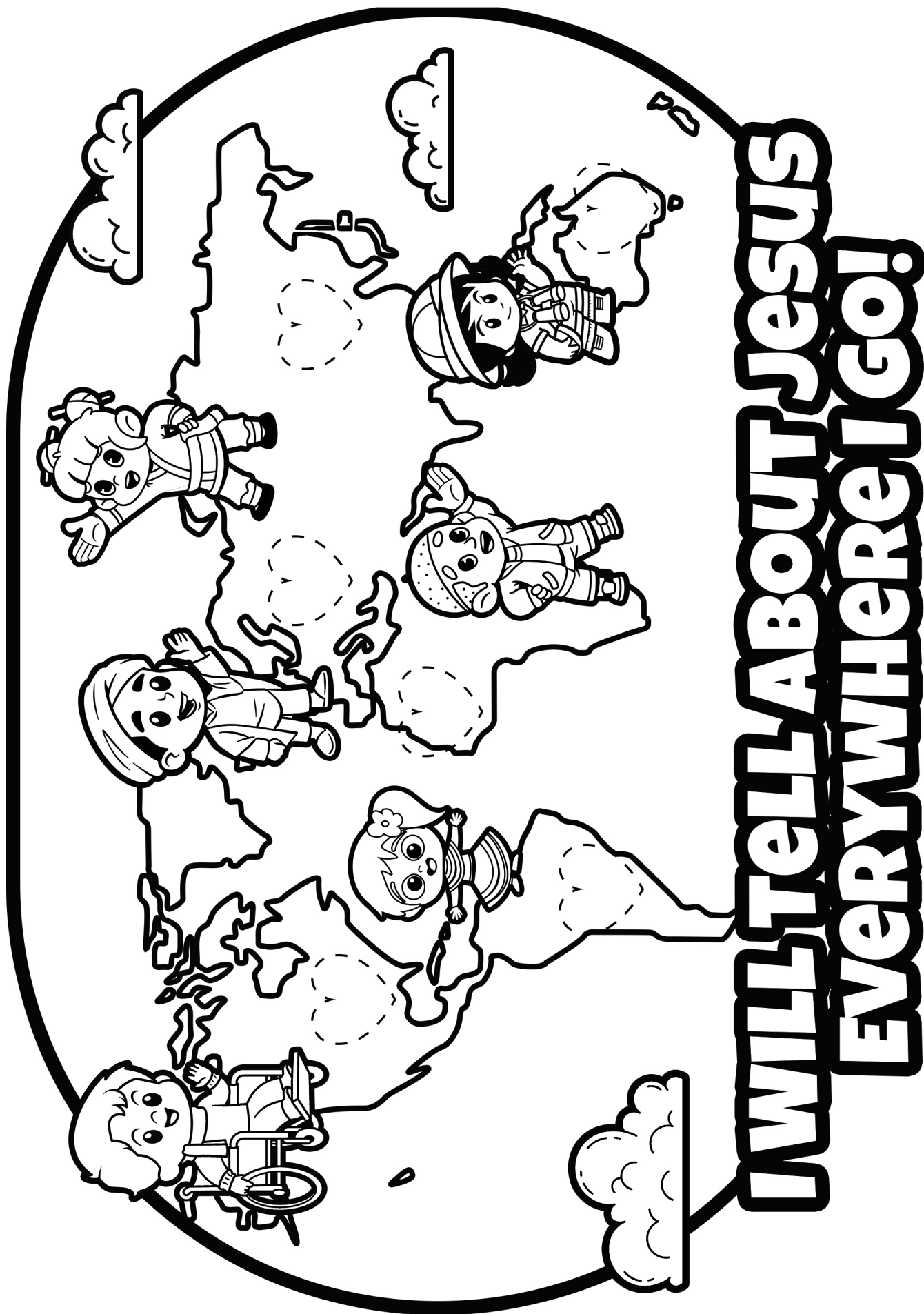


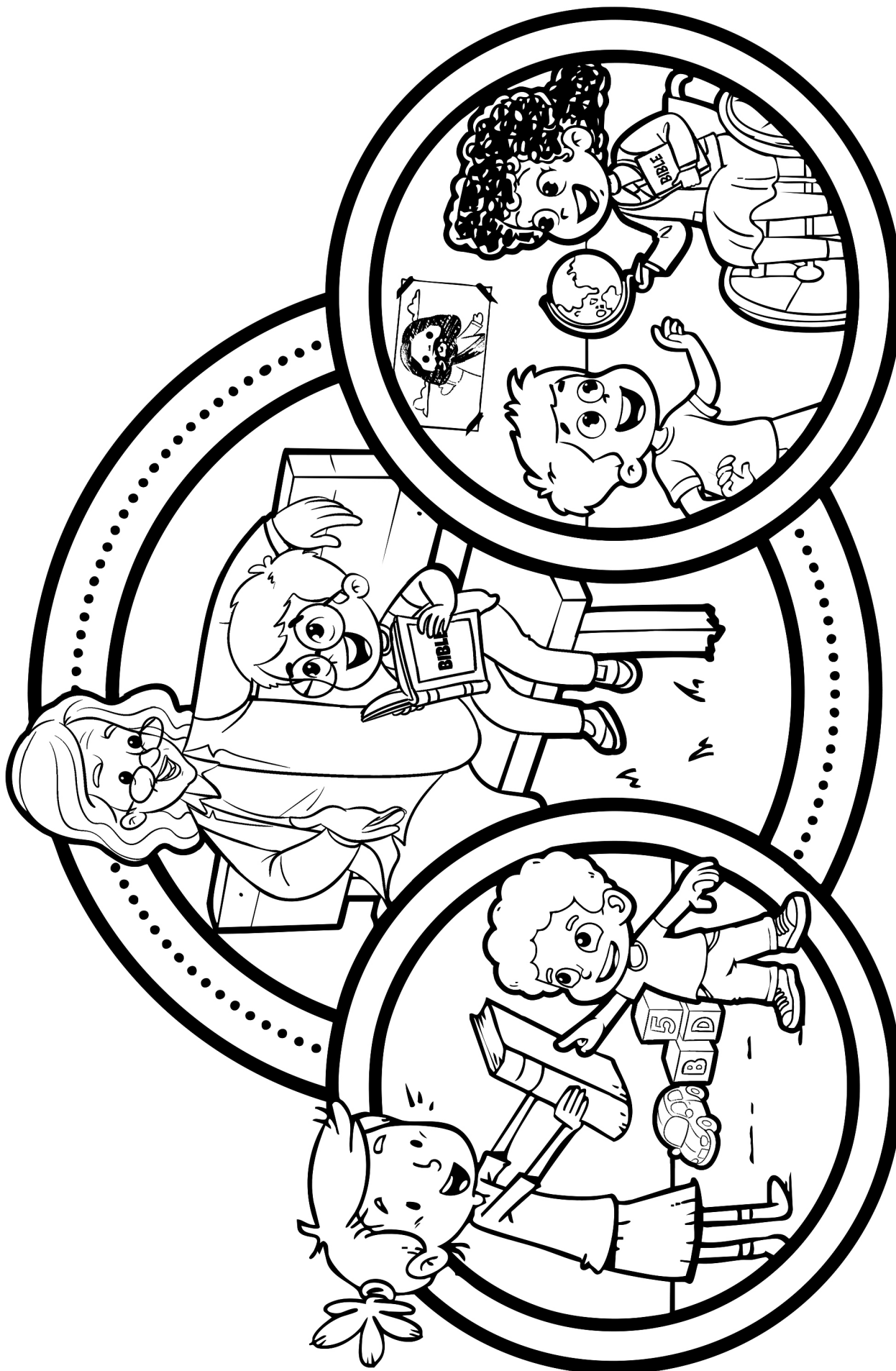
