Hunger and food insecurity are prevalent throughout the metropolitan area, and the food pantry at Jewish Family Services is there to help.

- 20% – 25% of local families with children struggle to put food on the table.
- Many families do not qualify for federal assistance, or their benefits are limited, and government assistance often doesn't cover household and personal hygiene items.
- The JFS pantries offer fresh produce, dairy items, and even pet food.
- Each month, JFS distributes over 29,000 pounds of food to more than 600 families. That includes more than 3,000 rolls of toilet paper a month!
