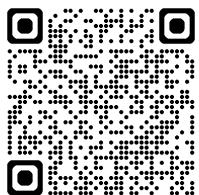

ENCOURAGEMENT

I recall that Martyn Lloyd-Jones made the statement that, "If you have a problem with sins, then you have a problem with sin". This seemingly simple statement is packed with a powerful truth. Sin is the forsaking of God and what He offers vs someone else and what that person or entity offers.

We have recently heard the preaching on the parable of the prodigal in Luke 15. The younger son forsook his father for what he might have thought were greener pastures. His initial turning from what he had in his father's house is similar to what Eve and Adam did in their Father's house (the garden). Each of these initial decisions to forsake and turn to others or other things led to more and more personal and societal corruption.

The heart of the matter is very simple! We make it complicated, don't we?

Our many frequently repeated sins have to do with our initial decision to forsake God. We must look in the mirror of His word and see clearly who we are. We must come to ourselves as the younger son and return to the Father to abide in Him, in His house. We must reject the world and it's offerings that are against the creator of the world.

In today's world there seems to be more and more

trappings of sin that seem to be complicated or complex. People blame the allure of the difficulty of avoiding sin.

At the beginning of the world God offered everything needed while providing one simple command concerning eating of the fruit of the tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. It was not an intimidating calculus equation for us to solve. However, like Eve and Adam we forsake the cornucopia of good offerings for the one simple thing not permitted.

How grateful we should be that we have the transparency of His servant the Apostle Paul and his words in Romans 7:21-25. Our King Jesus is ready to redeem and restore! Brothers and sisters we must take a stand in our redeemed position and choose to mortify sin, the forsaking of God in our small and big actions so that we truly act like children wearing the robe of righteousness that Christ paid for with His precious blood!
