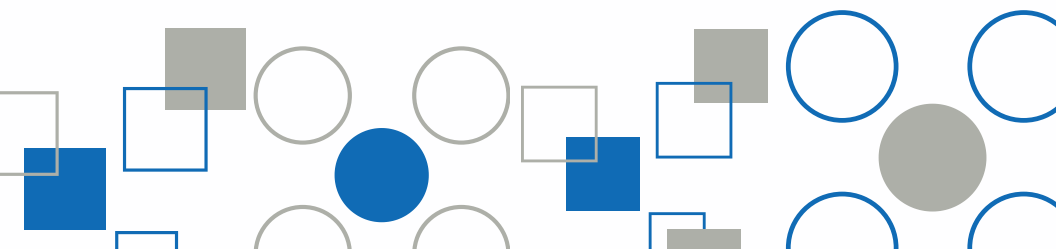
INTRODUCTION

- Day 7: Church






DAY 1: JESUS

We accept God's gift of eternal life by believing in Jesus Christ. Believing He is the Son of God, believing He died for our sins, and believing He was raised from the dead.

To accept Jesus as Lord means that you repent of sins and ask for His forgiveness. With that, you receive His help, guidance, protection, and strength every day that you live.

Take some time to think about these three aspects of Jesus being part of your life

1. Jesus Christ is your personal Savior and Lord.
 2. Jesus Christ loves you more than you will ever understand.
 3. Jesus has changed you completely. Tell others why you changed and that Jesus Christ is your Savior and Lord.




BIBLE VERSES

John 3:16 tells us, **God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son. that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.**

Romans 10:9-10 says, **If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart, one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth, confession is made unto salvation.** You have believed in Jesus Christ and received God's gift of salvation and eternal life!

Philippians 2:9-11 tells us, **God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.**



DAY 2: PRAYER

BUILD YOUR RELATIONSHIP

Prayer is a way to communicate and talk with God. God wants to know you and have a personal relationship with you.

In all relationships communication is critical to the health and well-being of the relationship.

When praying, talk to God like you are talking to your friend. Open your heart to Him and be sincere, honest, and loving.

When praying, our hope is for God's will to be done. We may not always love the decision but remember that God's Plan is perfect.

What to pray?

- Praise God for blessings in your life.
- Repent for sins.
- Ask for help to face temptations, challenges, or difficulties in your life.
- Give thanks for God's plan for your life.




BIBLE VERSES

Philippians 4:6 says, **Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.**

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 tells us, **Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.**

A great example of prayer said by Jesus is found in Matthew 6:9-13, ***Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.***






DAY 3: BORN AGAIN

God has empowered you to leave the old life behind and try to live like Christ. You are born again in Him. In your new life:

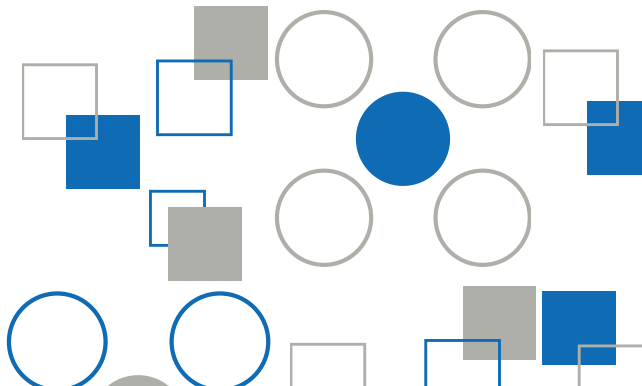
- Love God with all your heart.

BIBLE VERSES

How should we live now? In Matthew 22:36-40 a man asked Jesus, **Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?**

Jesus replied: ***Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself. All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.***

Being born again was a necessary step. In John 3:5-7, Jesus said, ***Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, You must be born again.***

THE WORD OF GOD

The Bible is the inspired, the only infallible authoritative Word of God, without error in the autographed versions.

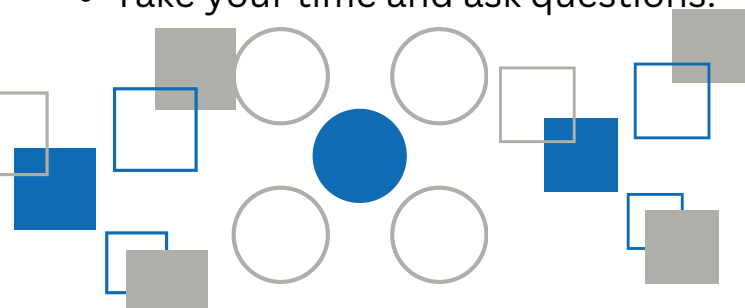
The Bible is the complete revelation of God's will for salvation, and the ultimate authority by which every realm of human knowledge and endeavor should be judged.

- Take your time and ask questions.

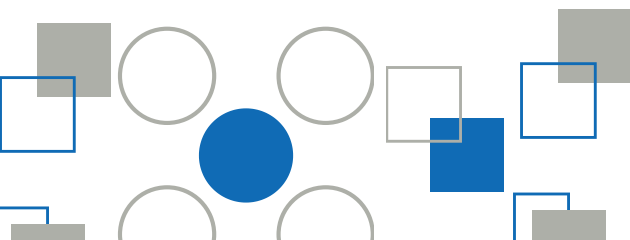


BIBLE VERSES
