Pastor: Brothers and Sisters in Christ, I have good news for you. Your Heavenly Father is full of mercy and His love never fails. He has sent His only begotten Son to live a perfect life on this earth, and to die on the cross for the punishment our sins deserve. Risen from the dead, Christ

comes to us today with fresh grace and forgiveness, that we may abound with thankfulness and generosity. Therefore, as a servant of the Word and by the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the Name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
