The Accuser, Satan, was there at the angel's right hand, making accusations against Jeshua.



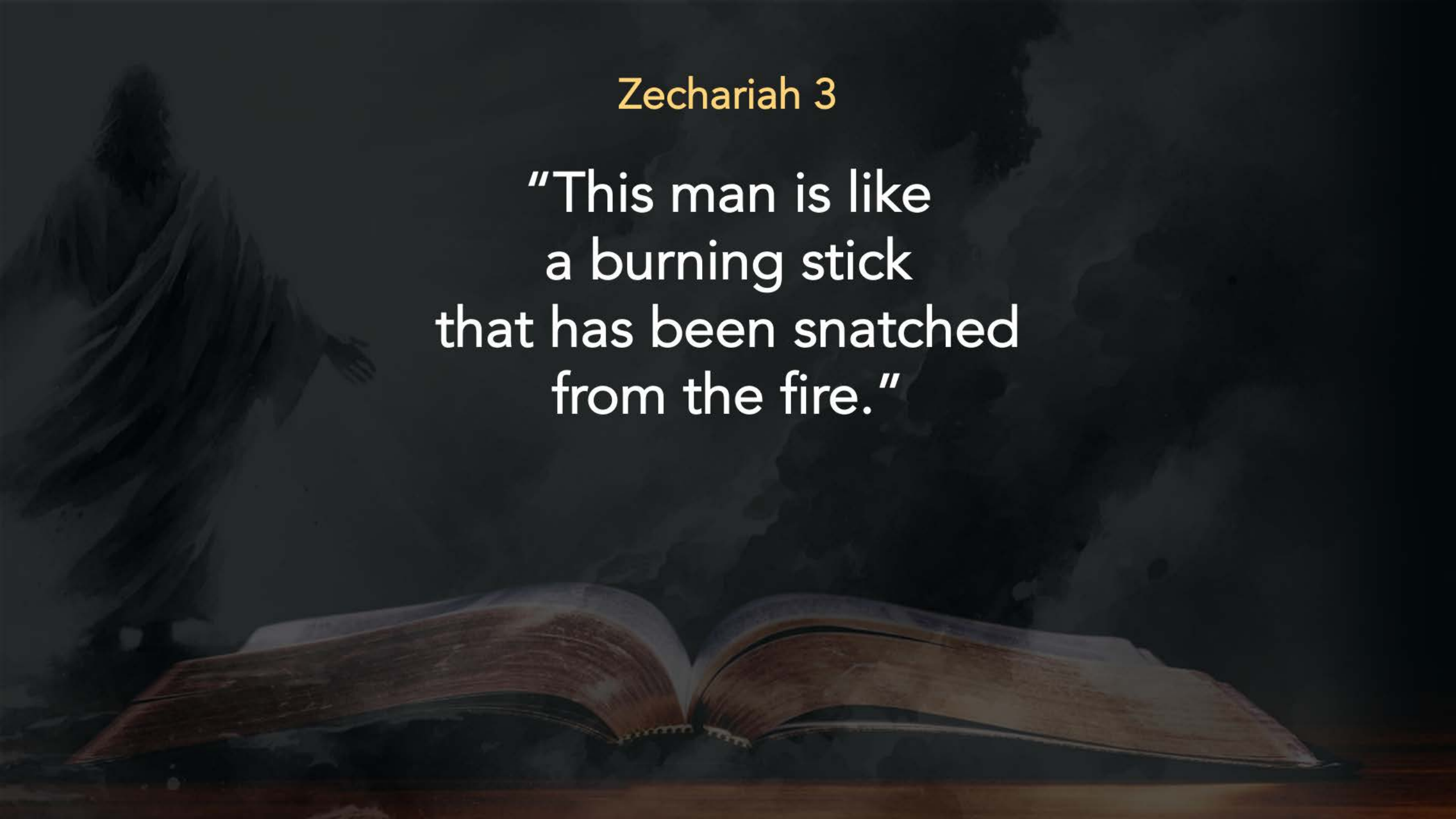
Zechariah 3

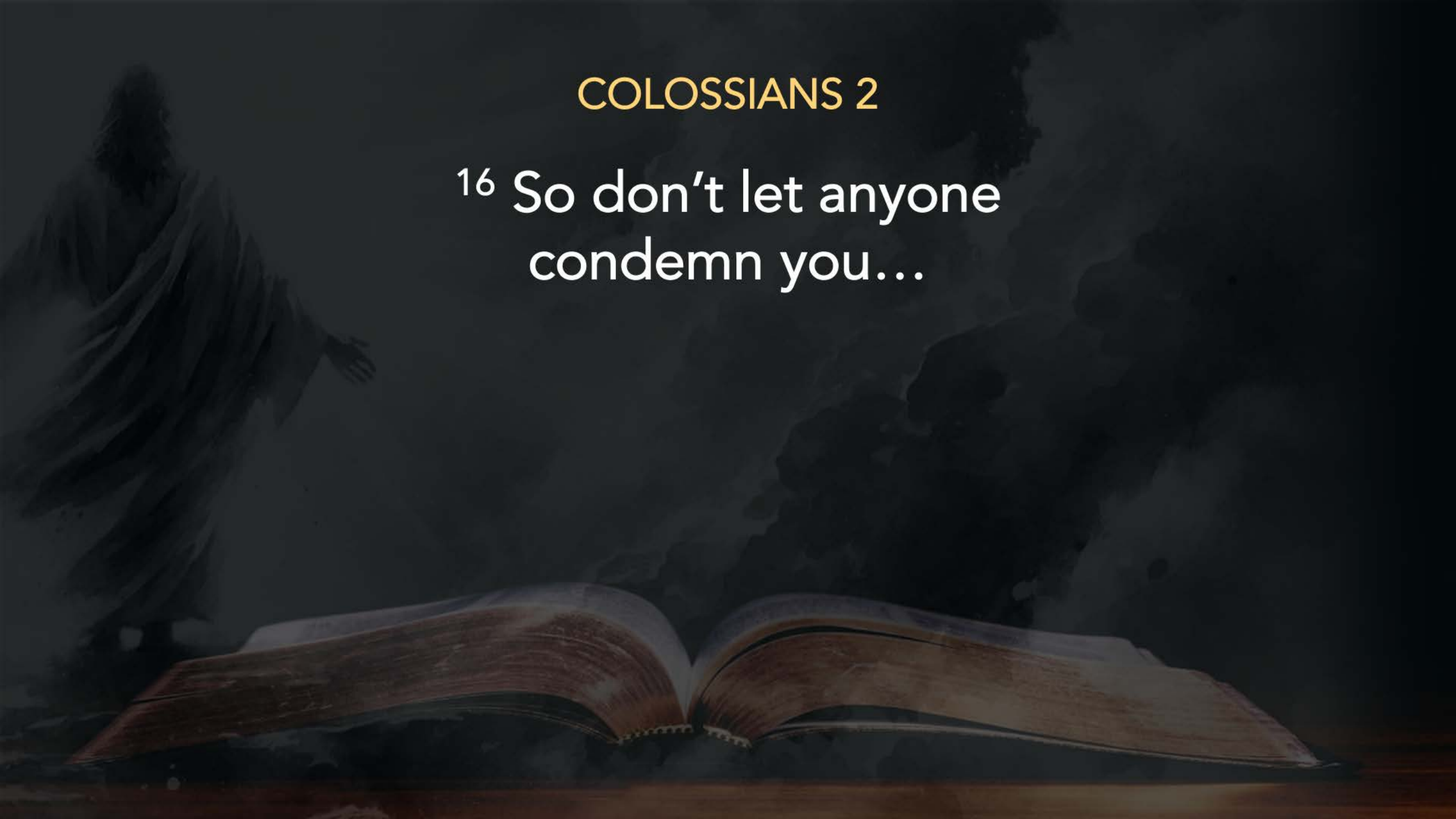
¹⁴ He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.

in the heavenly realms and on earth.



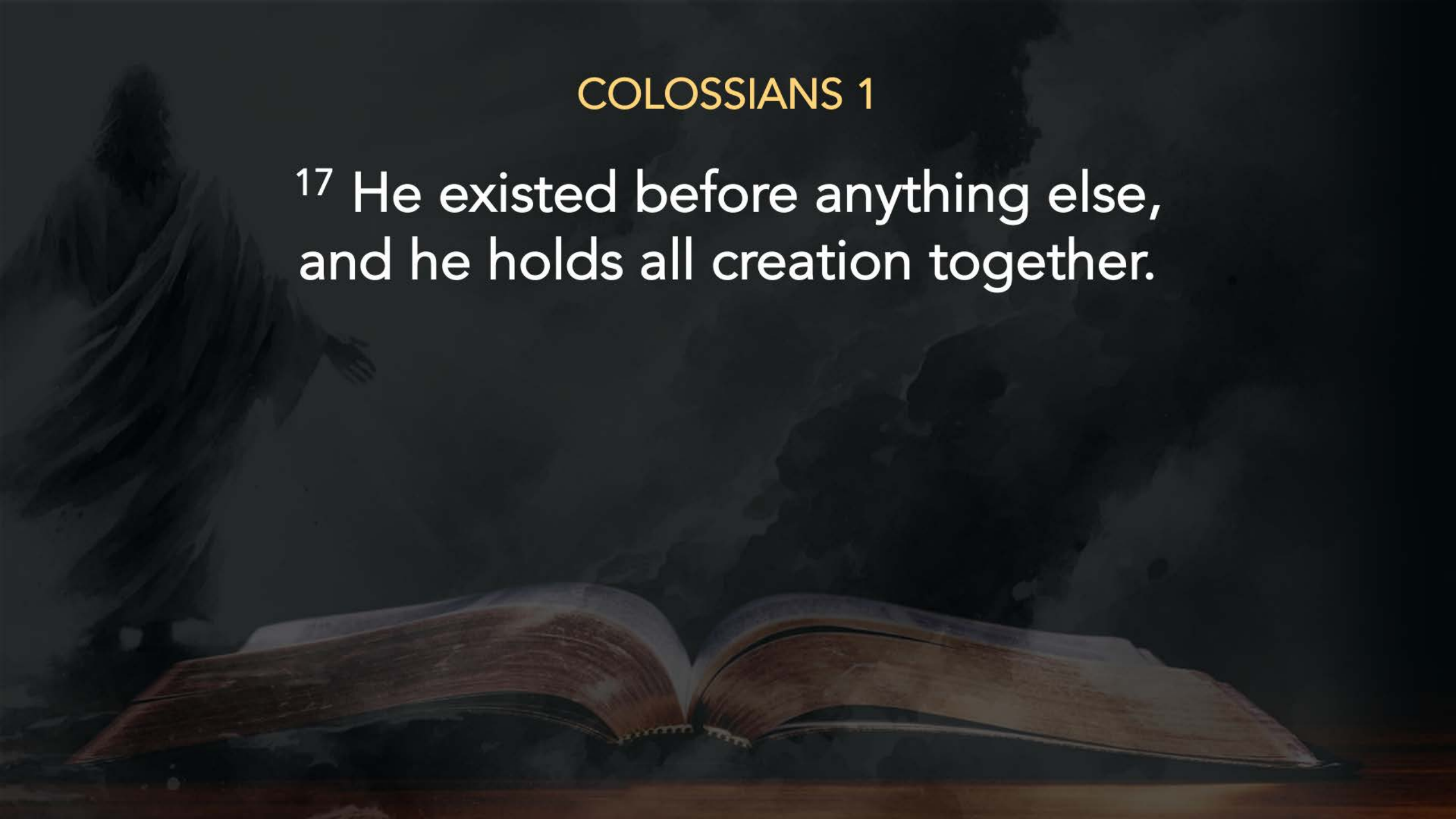
COLOSSIANS 1
