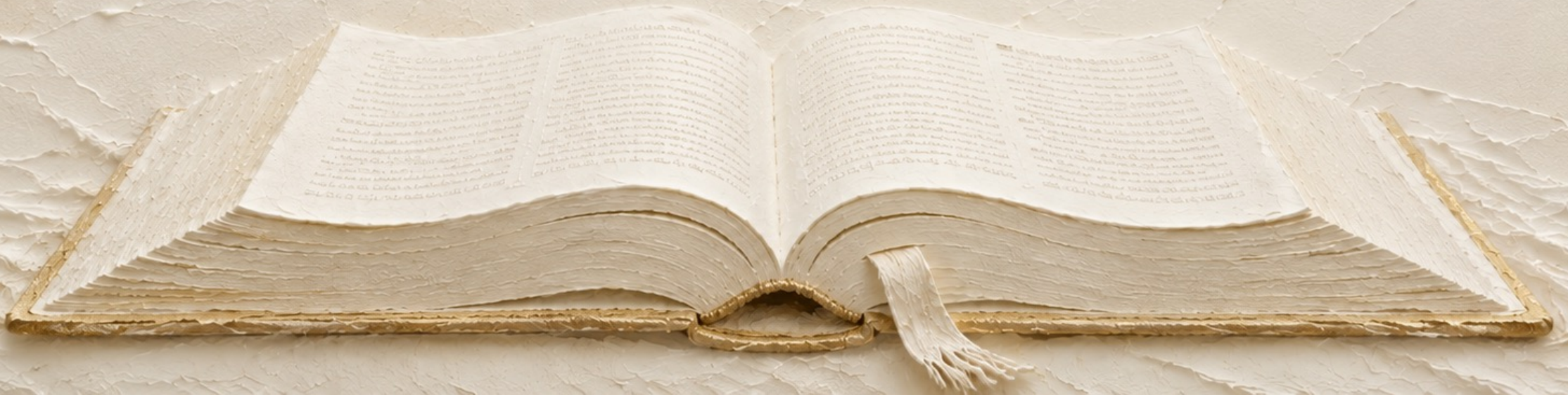

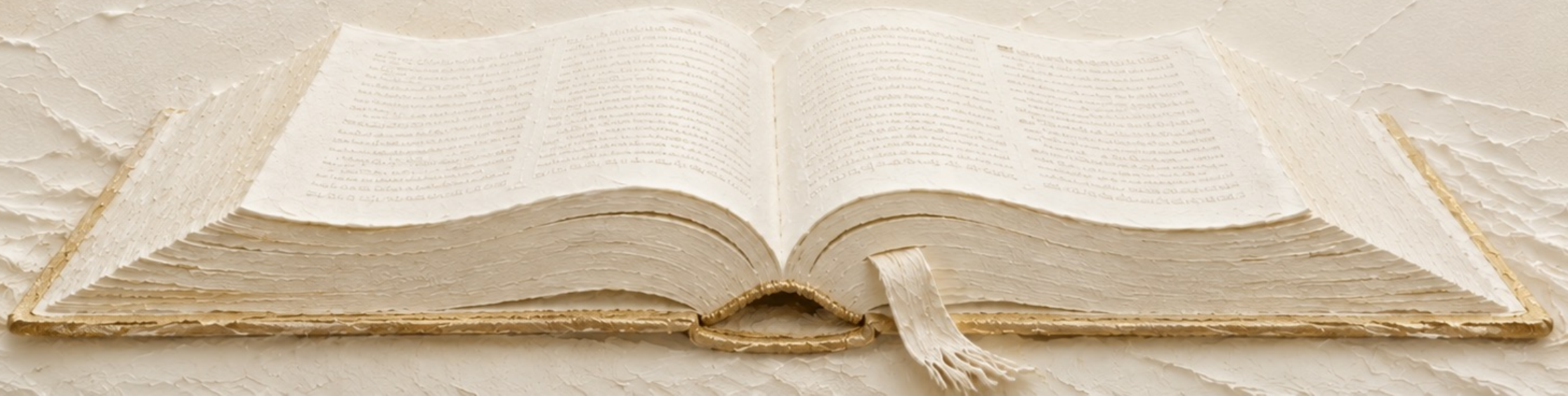






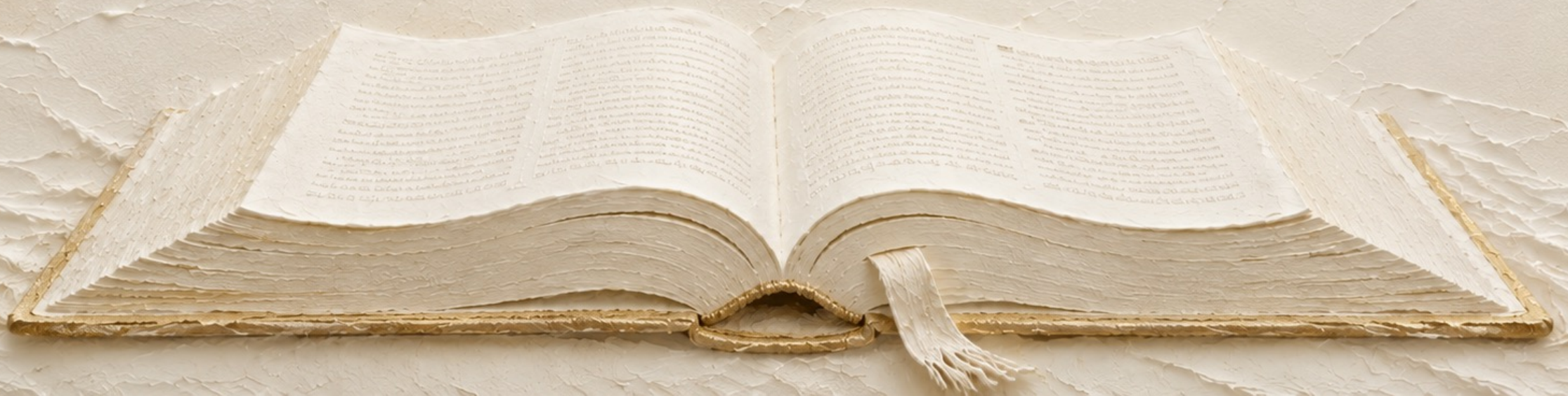

they went to the Jewish synagogue.



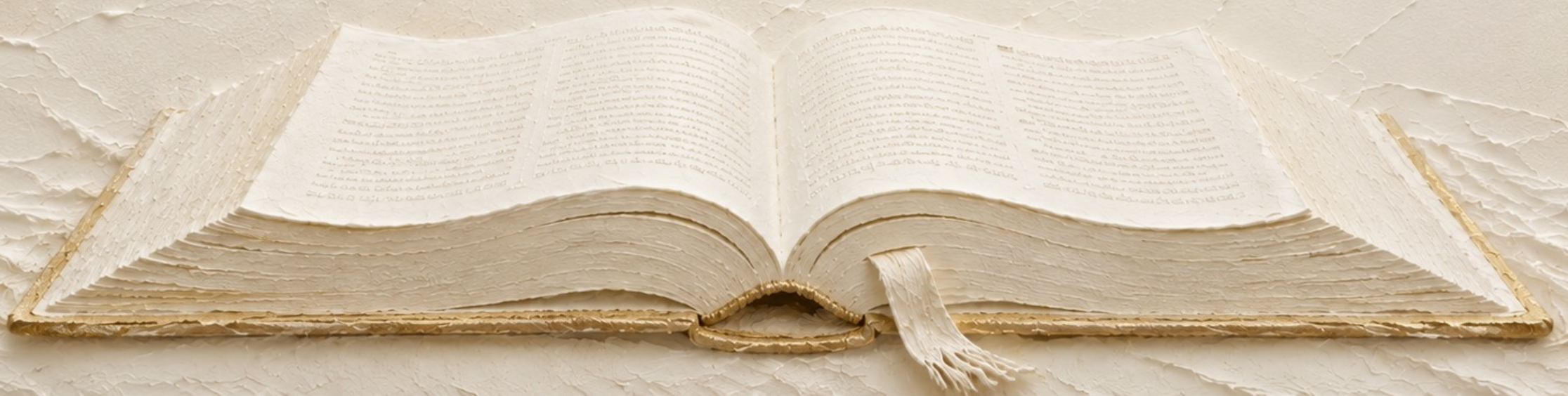

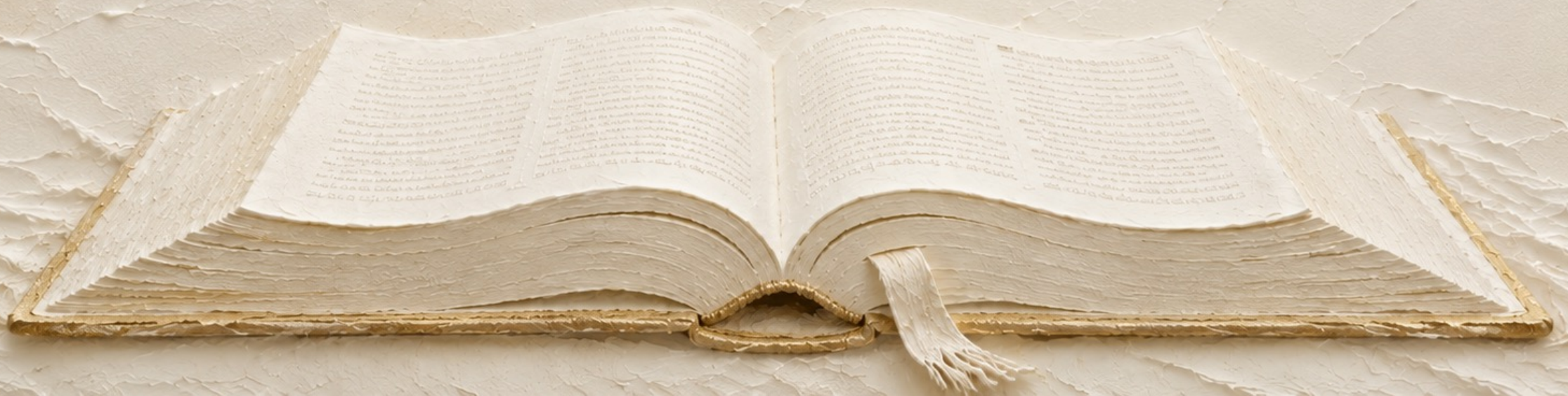

and many Greek men.



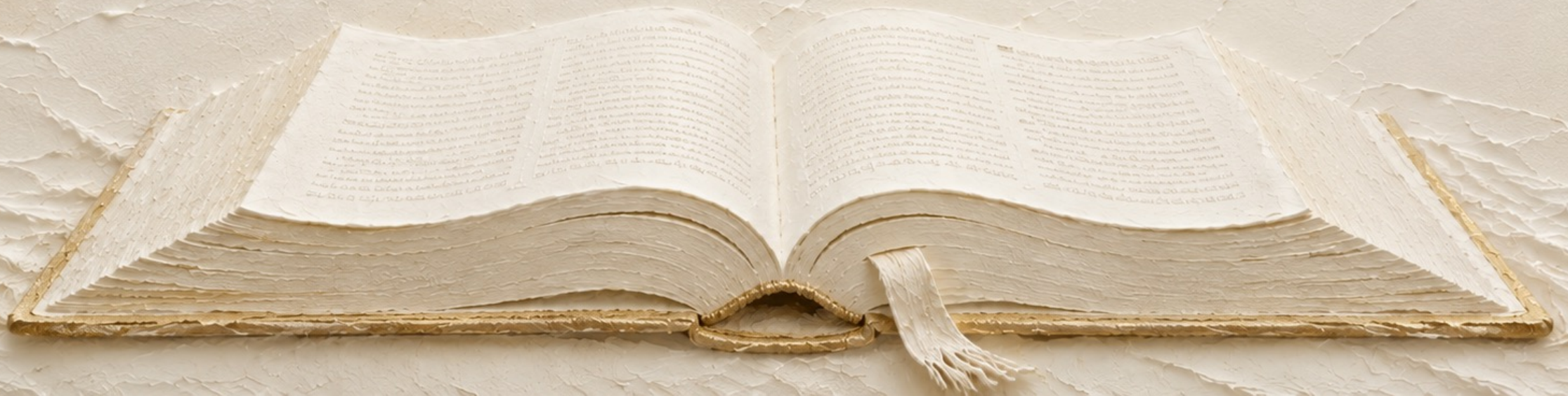

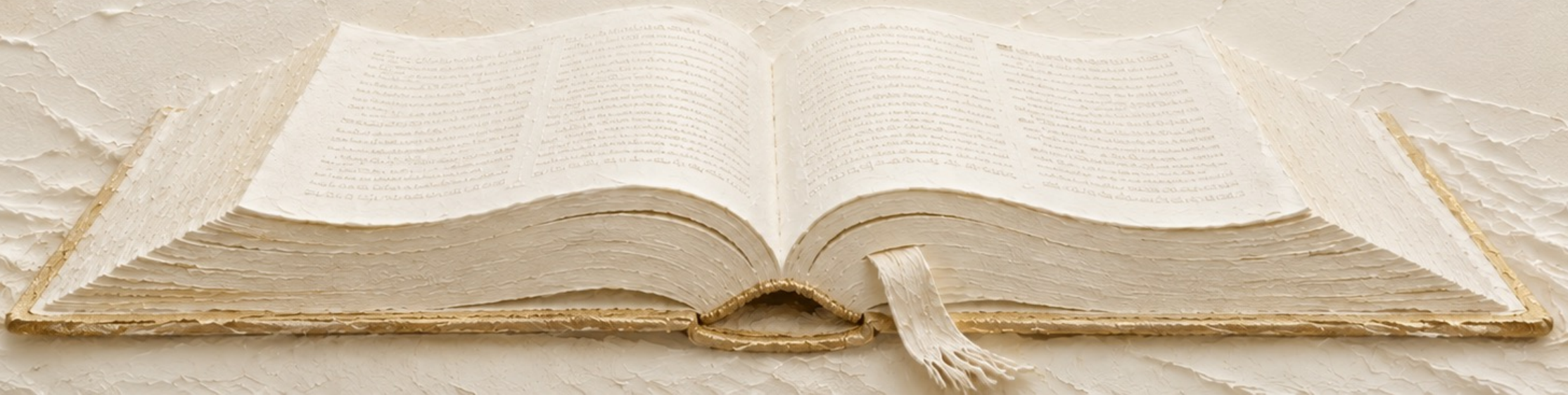
- ¹⁴ The believers immediately sent Paul to the coast,

to join him as soon as possible.





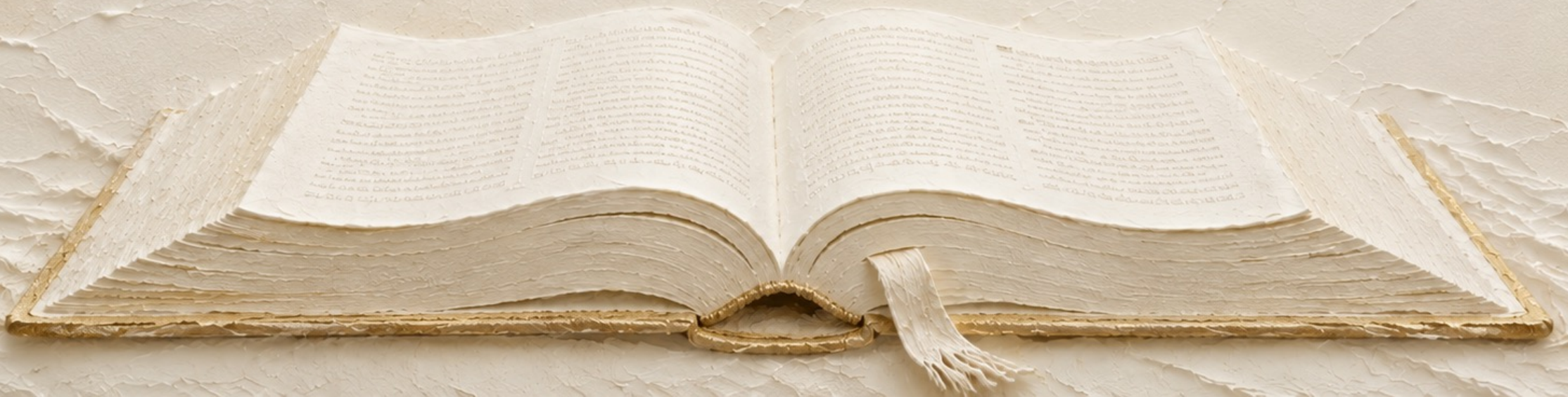

it is of no value, and only ruins those who listen.



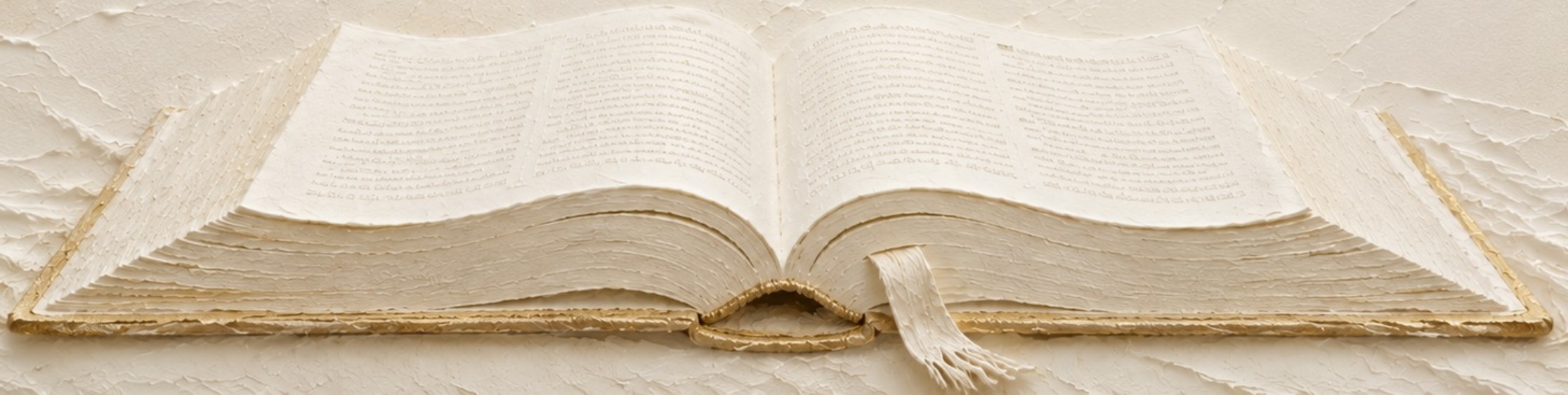

and who correctly handles the word of truth.



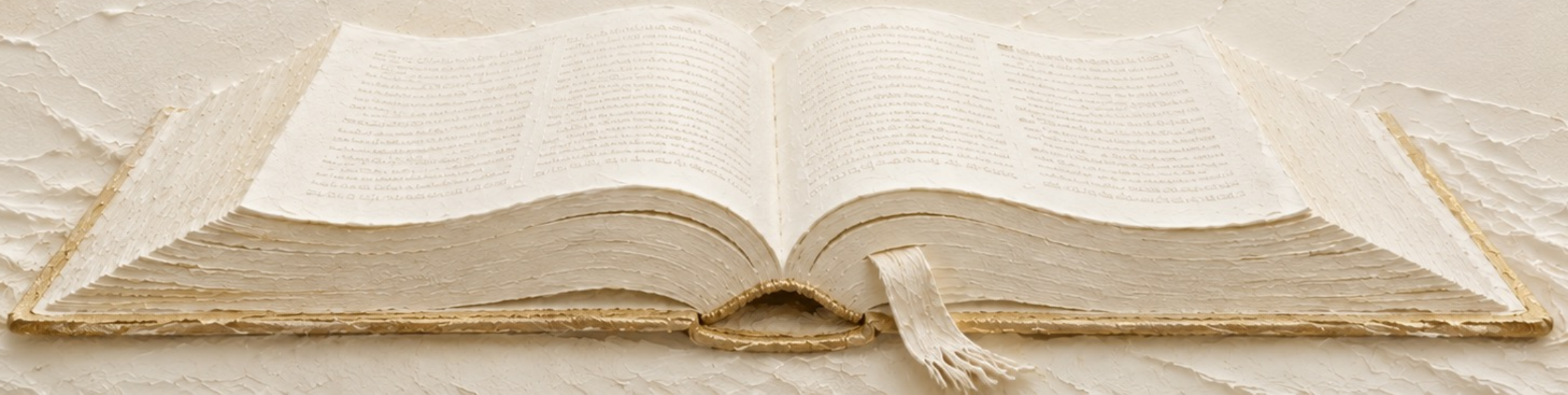
