## GENESIS 3



## HEBREWS 2


17 For this reason he had to be made like them,

heaven was opened




## LUKE 3

<sup>2</sup> where for forty days he was tempted by the devil.


He ate nothing during those days,

## LUKE 4


<sup>5</sup> The devil led him up to a high place and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world.

<sup>9</sup> The devil led him to Jerusalem and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down from here.




## LUKE 4

to guard you carefully;


<sup>11</sup> they will lift you up in their hands,
