Each course includes:

- Ministry assignments
- Knowledge checks
- Mentor discussions

The purpose of Phase One is to strengthen both spiritual maturity and practical ministry skills.

Step 3 – Ministry Evaluation

Upon completion of Phase One, ministry leadership will review:

- Spiritual growth
- Faithfulness
- Classroom participation
- Child safety practices
- Teamwork
- Teachability
- Ministry readiness

Successful completion of Phase One demonstrates a commitment to continued growth and may open the door to additional ministry responsibilities and leadership opportunities.
