





Explanation of the Lord's Supper

Tonight, we stop for a short time to remember and to meditate upon the cross and to partake of the elements of the Lord's Supper. Would you listen for the still small voice of God as you prepare to come to the Lord's table?

When it is time for the Lord's Supper, we will ask that all the worshippers move to the outer walls of the sanctuary. You will then move forward in a line to pick up the elements for the Lord's Supper on the side that you are seated. After you pick up the bread and the cup, move down the center aisle of the sanctuary back to your seat and wait for the Pastor's instructions in receiving the Lord's Supper. Remember - do not partake of the elements until the Pastor leads you to do so.
