

Daniel's 70 Weeks: A Prophecy of Hope, Not a Prophecy of Confusion Daniel 9:20 – 27

- I. A Prophecy of Hope: God is Faithful and Hears Your Prayers. 9:20 – 23
- II. Not a Prophecy of Confusion: Clarifying the word “weeks.”
9:24

Hebrew – “Seventy Sevens” = 490 Years
- III. A Prophecy of Hope: God is Faithful and He Himself Provides Atonement for your sin. 9:24
- IV. Not a Prophecy of Confusion: A Prediction of Jesus Christ's Death. 9:25 – 26a

69 weeks = 483 Lunar years

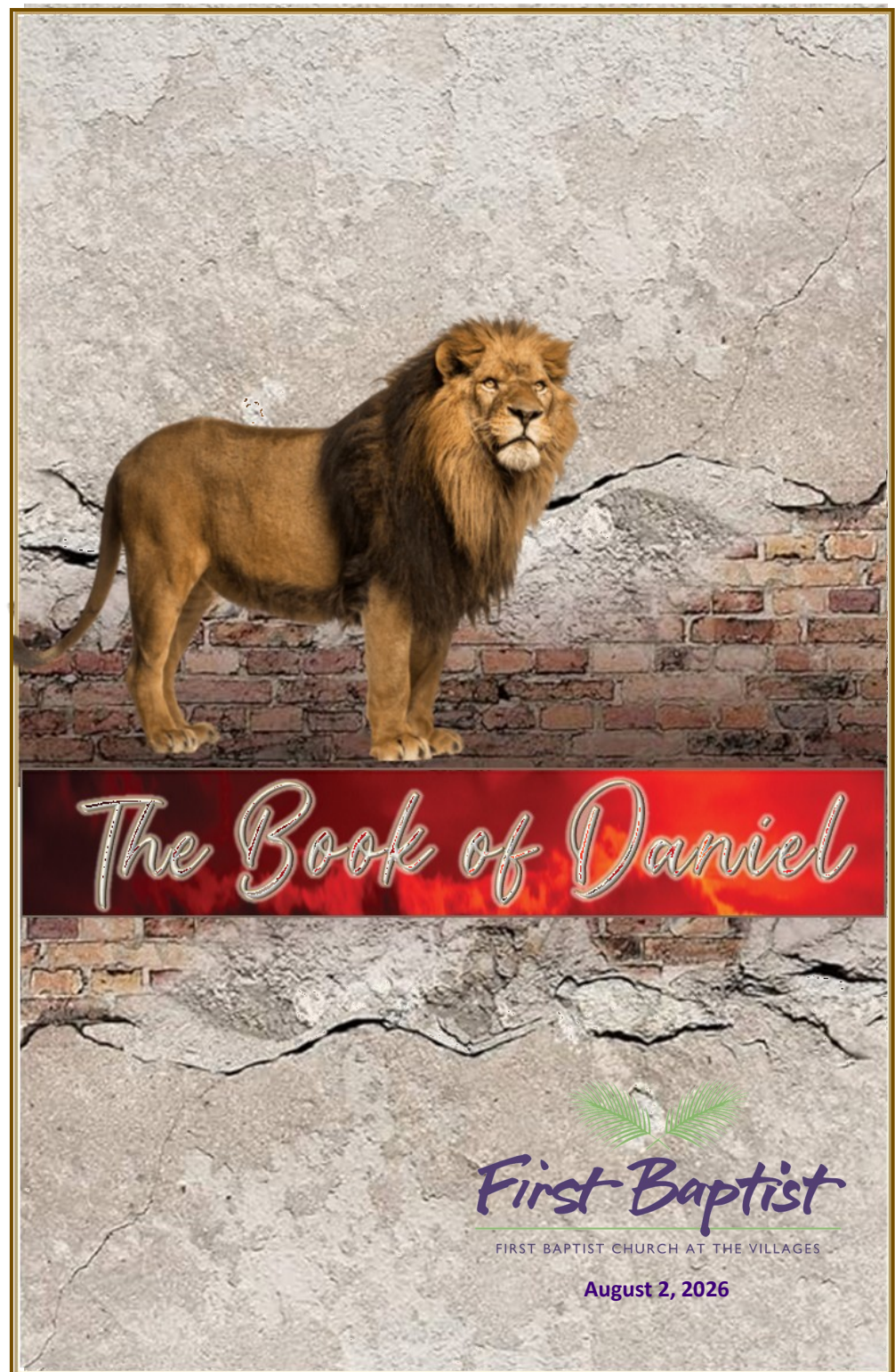
The decree to restore Jerusalem: *Nehemiah 2:1* tells precisely when this decree of Daniel 9:25 was issued “in the month Nisan, in the twentieth year of King Artaxerxes.” March-April of 444 BC.

The Messiah is “cut off” – March / Early April 33 AD
- V. A Prophecy of Hope: Evil Will Not Have the Final Word. 9:26b – 27

The Messiah = Jesus

“The prince who is to come” = Antichrist
- VI. Not a Prophecy of Confusion: A Gap Between the 69th and 70th Weeks 9:27

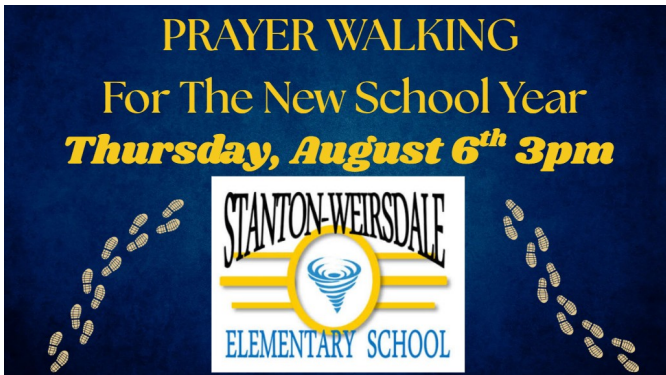
