ANSWER: BORN FROM ABOVE. JOHN 3:3

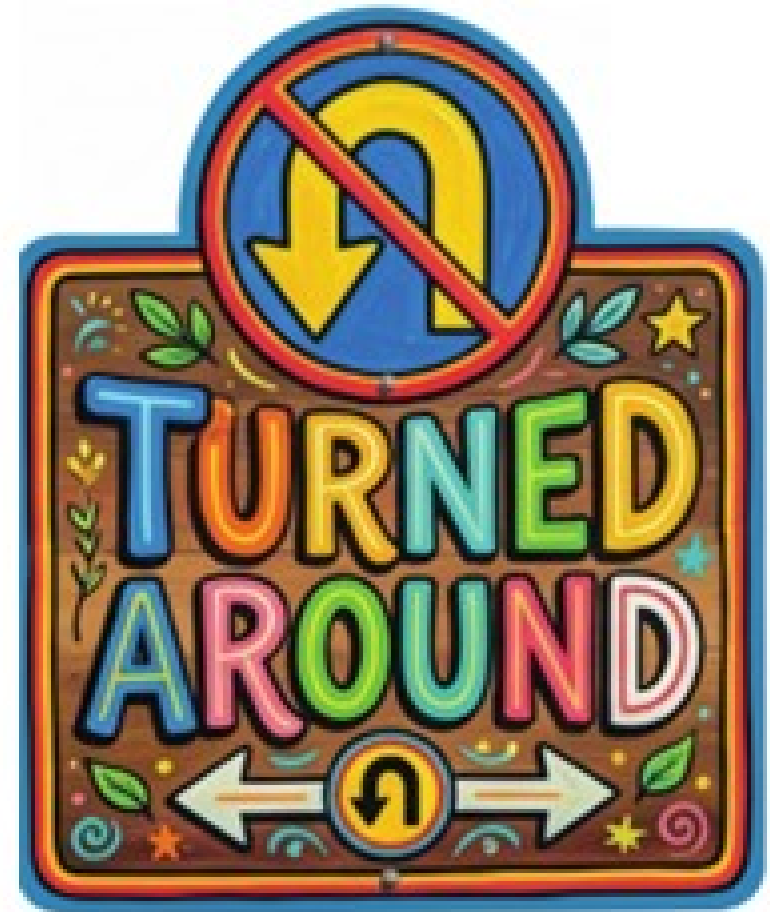
V. HOW ARE WE BORN AGAIN?
