DANIEL 6:1 – 10**

1. To live with integrity means a person's private life aligns with his or her public persona. Daniel 6:3, 10

⇒ A Paradigm for Integrity: Your private life; Your personal life; Your professional life; Your public life.

2. To live with integrity means a person's life continues to be distinguished by consistent excellence in different situations and over an extended time. 6:3a

3. To live with integrity means a person's character is notable for its excellence. 6:3b

4. To live with integrity means to live above corruption. 6:4

5. To live with integrity means convictions don't change when circumstances change. 6:5 – 9

6. To live with integrity means to worship God in thankfulness. 6:10

Spiritually: Jesus is Lord. Romans 10:9 – 10

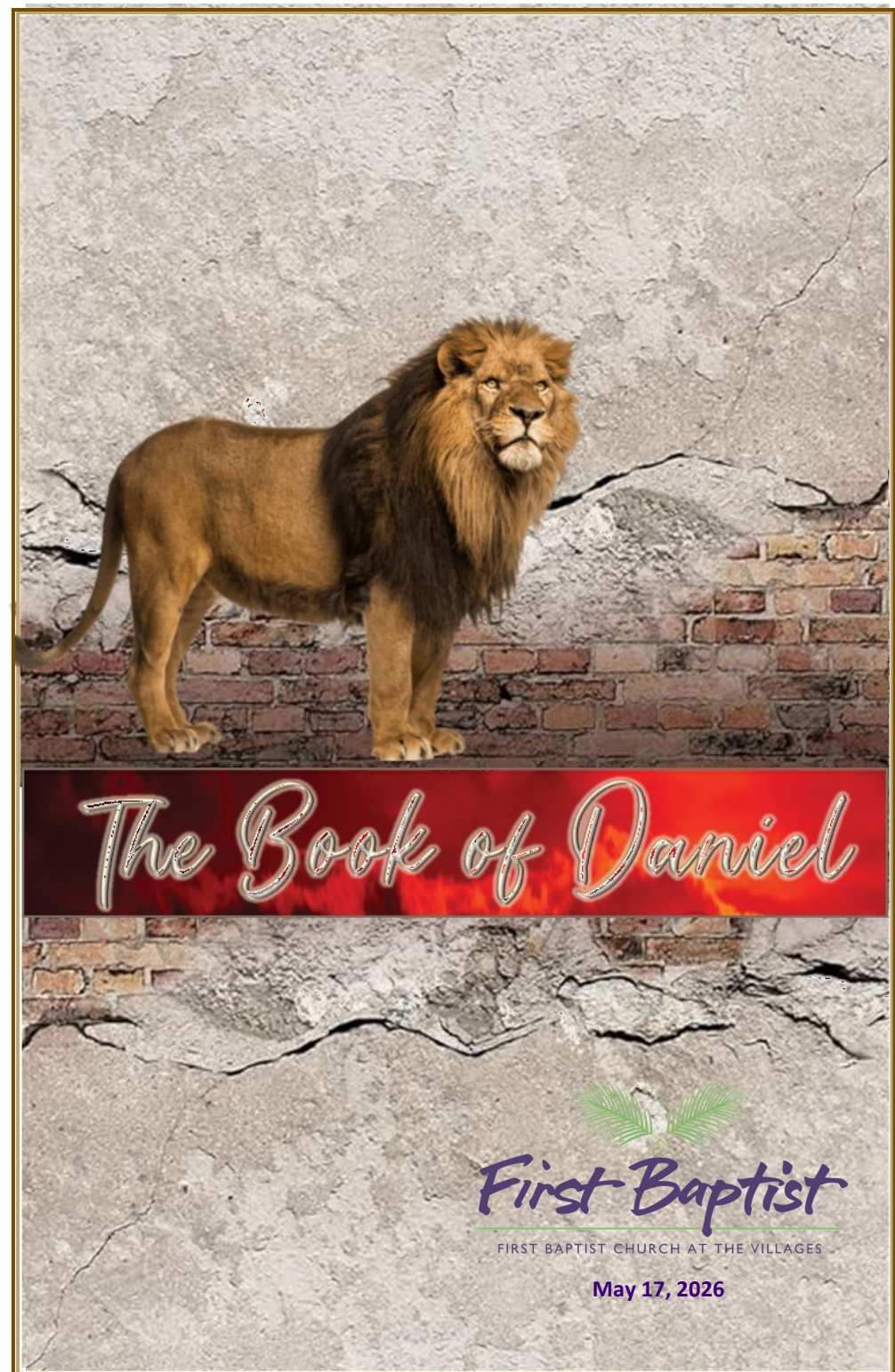
Intellectually: Fear of the Lord is the beginning of Wisdom. Proverbs 1:7
