As our Search Team begins reviewing resumes and meeting candidates, prayer support is critical in their discerning of God's will and direction for who will fill the positions of **Worship Pastor and Discipleship Pastor.**

Prayer Support and A Prayer Guide

BIBLICAL FOUNDATION:

- John 15:7-8. Prayer=(God's) Perspective.
- We seek Jesus for alignment with Him, not to gain answers from Him. (Matthew 16:18 "...I will build My church" {I will appoint My leaders})
- We seek Jesus by listening to, and for, Him. (John 17:1-26; v.24 "Father, I desire...")
- We LEARN MORE by listening than by speaking. (Psalm 46:10 "Be still/quiet and/to know that I am God.")

DAILY PRAYER CONTEXT:

- Marinate in John 14:1-15; John 15:1-16; John 16:7-14; John 17:1-26
- Marinate requires **extended delegated TIME.**
- **Set aside "other things"** to delegate extended TIME TO MARINATE IN JESUS

One Accord

7 Days in One Accord... A Time of Focused Prayer

March 23—March 29, 2026

Monday: Praise and Purify. Psalm 139. Celebrate the Person of God/Elohim. He is all-knowing; all-powerful; always present. Be purified by His search and our surrender. V.23-24. In the context of v.1-22 reflecting the holiness of God, allow the Holy Spirit to search your heart motive, uncover any anxieties and so-called wicked ways. Any way other than His way is a wicked way. Confess, repent and be refreshed by His forgiveness.

Tuesday: Pause and Position. Psalm 46. "God is..." So, "Be still and know..." Allow the Lord to reveal Himself, His supremacy and sovereignty through the context of v.1-9. Then obey Him by being still/quiet before Him to know Him intimately with a heart positioned for obedience.

Wednesday: Petition for Partnership. Acts 4:24-37. Note "one voice" and "one heart." This "search process" is more about our personal and corporate alignment with the Lord and one another than about finding new staff personnel.

Thursday: Petition for Power. Ephesians 6:10-20; especially v.17-20. All biblical prayer is combative in nature. We are never not in spiritual warfare.

Friday: Petition for Perspective. John 17:20-24. Gain Jesus' perspective and pray alongside Him.

Saturday: Petition for Predetermined Staff. Romans 8:26-34. Jesus has His appointing hand on those whom He has selected to join us. Pray for them to hear Him.

Sunday: Praise! Praise! Praise! Ephesians 3:20-21. "To Him be glory in the church."
