



KEY SCRIPTURE

John 20:15-16 | 15 Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" Supposing him to be the gardener, she said to him, "Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away." 16 Jesus said to her, "Mary." She turned and said to him in Aramaic, "Rabboni!" (which means Teacher).

TAKEAWAYS

Our faith did not raise Jesus from the dead; God's power & His love for us did.

The empty tomb is the banner of victory in our lives, it declares we are free.

The victorious king knows you & calls you by name.

QUESTIONS

1. ***Pastor Eddie shared that it wasn't our faith that raised Jesus, but God's power and His love.*** How does that shift the way you see your faith, your purpose, or even your pressure to "get it right"?
2. ***The empty tomb declares victory and freedom.*** Are there areas in your life where you're still believing lies instead of walking in that freedom? What are they?
3. ***In John 20:16, Jesus calls Mary by name in the middle of her confusion.*** Do you believe Jesus knows you personally and is speaking into your life? Why or why not?

ACTION STEPS

This week, when negative thoughts or doubts come, remind yourself: the tomb is still empty.
Choose one area where you've been believing a lie, and replace it with truth; Jesus is King, and I have victory through Him.
