Dear Parents,

Welcome to AWANA! Our **FIRST night will be August 12, 2026**, from 6pm – 7:15pm.

What is AWANA?

AWANA is a Bible club for ages 4 through 5th grade. It contains handbook time (scripture verse memorization exercises), counsel time (a Biblical story relayed in a way that is easy to understand), game time (LOTS of fun), and award time (kids will be rewarded for their achievements when they memorize their Bible verses).

What to expect?

Awards: When children pass their entrance booklet, which they receive free on the first night, they can earn the privilege of receiving a uniform and their first book. You will then receive a note for payment of the book and uniform. It is important that the children have both the book and uniform to be able to earn awards. We do not want any child to be excluded from AWANA because of the cost. If you need to set up a payment plan or if there is a problem with the cost, please see one of the AWANA secretaries.

Points: If you registered your child before August 12 (either using the QR code or by signing the registration/consent form), they have already earned some AWANA points. Other ways to earn points: wear uniform, wear tennis shoes (required to participate in game time), bring Bible and handbook, bring a friend, good behavior and checking in by 6:00. These points can be used in the AWANA Store to buy items they choose. Dates of Store Nights are on the calendar.

What time and where?

5:50 – 6:00 Sanctuary - Parent/guardian check-in your children (pre-K children go to the pre-school building)
6:00 – 7:15 Various rooms - Volunteers will bring your children to each activity per the schedule
7:15 Fellowship Hall - Awards Ceremony (parents welcome to attend)
After Awards Ceremony - Parents check-out children from their classrooms (main hall of education building)
