WELCOMING

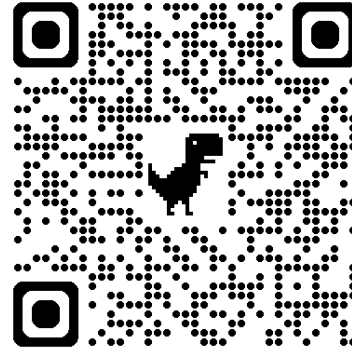
- Students will be committed to serving & loving others

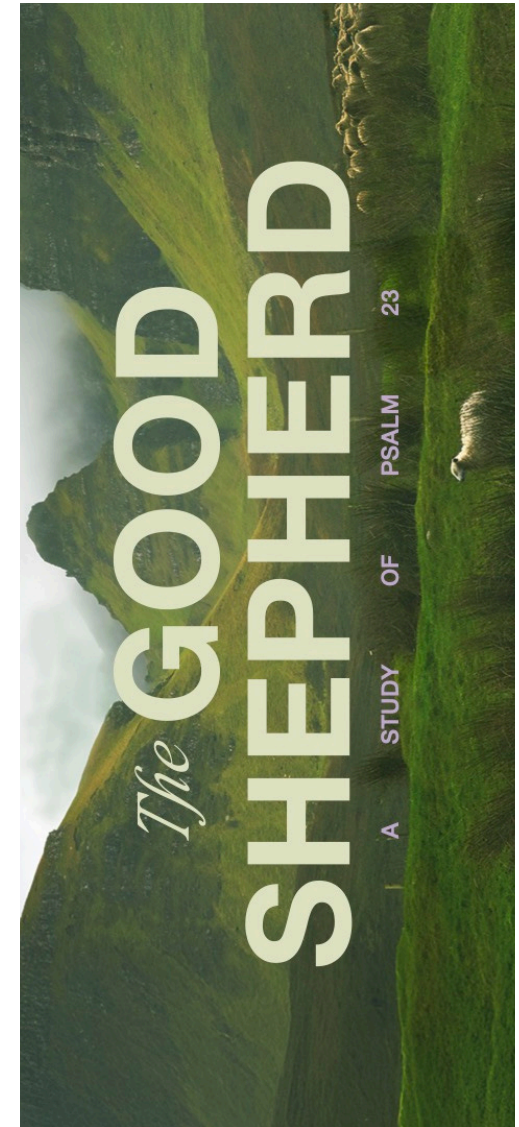

DRESS CODE

- Wear modest shorts (when hands are extended to the back or the front, finger tips must touch fabric). Sleeveless shirts and tank tops are allowed during day-time activities. *Shirts with spaghetti straps, open backs, or excessive armpit cutouts which expose torso and undergarments, or that show midriff are NOT allowed.* Large t-shirts that cover shorts should not be worn.
- Wear closed-toe and closed-heel shoes while at recreation and track times and during Mega Relay.
- Wear modest, one-piece bathing suits or two-piece suits covered with a dark colored t-shirt, if participating in water activities.
- Wear modest shorts, pants, jeans, or dresses for worship.
- Maintain good hygiene.
- Do not dress in a way that calls attention to underwear (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistbands, etc.) or wear pants or shorts with lettering on the bottom
